

Buckeye Lake Yacht Club Covid-19 Guidelines

The Board's primary objective with reopening the Club is to be in compliance with State of Ohio rules in order to provide a safe environment for our members and staff. We need every member to do the following to help us stay open through the remainder of this pandemic:

- If you are sick, **STAY HOME!** That goes for any illness, but especially if you have Covid-19 symptoms like a cough, fever or shortness of breath.
- Practice **social distancing**, wear a mask when possible and wash your hands often. Six feet is further than you think after you've had a couple drinks.
- The staff did not make the rules. Rodney collaborates with the Flag Officers and provides instruction to the staff. So, if you disagree with the way things are being done, please **do not shoot the messengers**. Take it up with Rodney or your Board.
- Follow the **new rules** we have implemented; they are there for your safety, staff safety and compliance with State mandates. The pool rules are of particular focus to remain open for the season.
- Furniture - tables, chairs and the like are placed to meet the social distancing requirements. Please **do not move furniture** about the island, inside or outside, without checking first and don't assume its ok.
- Please **read the State requirements and guidelines** for reopening bars and restaurants to gain an understanding what the Board and staff are trying to accomplish with the changes.
- We need your **patience and understanding** – new State and County rules come out on a regular basis and we must continuously adapt, so expect things to keep changing. We will do our best to adjust and make improvements.

Please observe the following pool rules:

Pool hours: 10 AM to dusk.

Family members only in pool area. NO guests. Club member or first mate must be present at the pool with family members.

Chairs: You must bring your own chair. NO Club pool chairs will be out. NO placing your chair around the pool grounds then leave the club to return later. When you leave, your chair leaves. High top tables with chairs will be available, but are not to be moved or combined.

NO toys, flotation rings/noodles/rafts, balls etc. are allowed in pool. NO throwing of anything or anyone.

If a family member needs a flotation device for safety it must be sanitized prior to it entering our pool.

Safe distancing is required. Masks are encouraged. Think of the other members in the pool.

Beverages in the pool are allowed. NO straws in drinks if being consumed in our pool. Throw all of your trash in the containers provided. Pick-up items you have dropped on the ground and dispose of them appropriately. Place your food or beverage order at the specified location at the bar.

If not in the pool no congregating - keep safe distancing - again masks are encouraged. Since you must bring your own chairs remember other members will be wanting to use the available spaces also, so be aware of your time at the pool.

Dining Tables: With outside dining available the tables around the pool might be used. If so, dining room chairs can be used but will be sanitized then removed after those diners are finished. Do not move the tables and chairs from their set position.

During peak hours of use you might be asked to not enter the pool area as there are too many in there already. Do not take offense at this request. It is for the safety of all. Please be courteous to other members and be aware of your time at the pool to allow other members access, especially on weekends.
