## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- a. The regatta will NOT be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing*

### 2. Eligibility

- a. All Buckeye Lake sailors, sailing fans, and BLYC Race Committee members with a Facebook account are eligible to participate.
- b. All participants must compete individually - no teams!

### 3. Registration

- a. Show up on the BLYC Facebook page at 1900 hours

### 4. Classes to be SAILED

- a. One fleet - all levels of skill, knowledge, and appropriate sarcasm are welcome!

### 5. FEES

- a. There are no fees (although bribing the PRO should be seriously considered)

### 6. SCHEDULE

### 7. RACES

- a. Three (3) "races" are scheduled consisting of a series of racing-related trivia questions.
- b. One (1) "race" constitutes a "regatta"
- c. The Race Committee (Steve Harris) may, at its discretion, increase or decrease the number of questions in each "race," weather permitting

## **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- a. The Race Committee will post one question at a time on the BLYC Facebook page
- b. Each new question will be a new post to the page
- c. The first participant to correctly answer the question in the comment field of the associated post will earn one point. The Race Committee will identify the name of the person who was first to answer correctly then proceed to posting the next question
- d. All decisions of the PRO are final (although, again, bribes *may* be considered)

## **9. SCORING**

- a. The High-Point Scoring system will be used - the participant with the most points wins!

## **10. AWARDS**

- a. Awards will be given for “Daily Firsts” (i.e. the winner of each week’s race) and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place overall. Awards are likely to be some variety of cheap, meaningless trinket, or possibly an adult beverage charged to the account of Race & Regatta Governor David Paligo, once the Club resumes normal operation.
