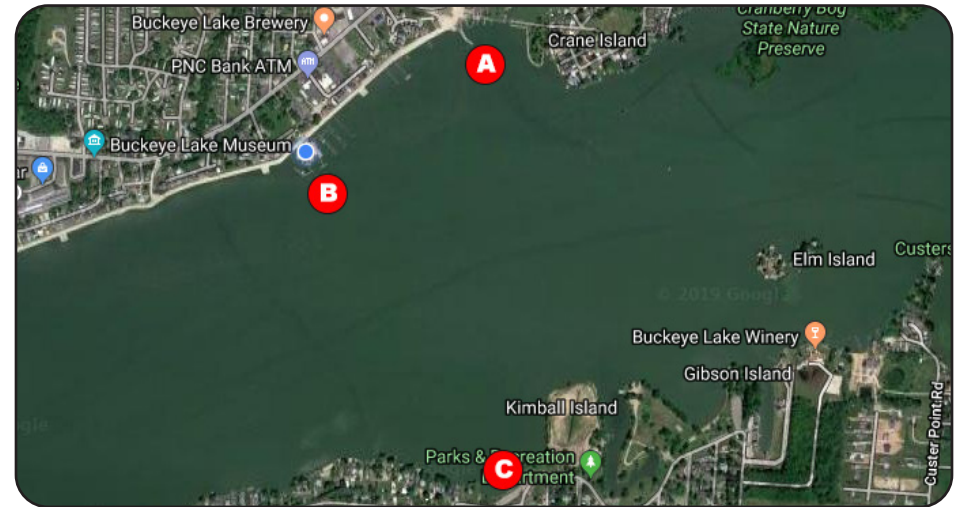
Emergency or Life Threatening Situation - Steps

1. Render Assistance
2. Make Contact with coaches, program staff, race committee, etc. for assistance
3. Call for Help & Emergency Medical Attention
 - **9-1-1**
 - **Buckeye Lake Watercraft** - VHF #16 - (740) 467-1517
 - **Buckeye Lake State Park** - VHF #16 - (740) 467-2690
 - **Buckeye Lake Yacht Club** - (740) 929-9941
4. Monitor and Administer First Aid
(AED is located in the bar area beside the back door)
5. Send someone to meet/direct Emergency vehicles
6. Transfer injured to care of Emergency Team
7. Debrief & Inform key people:
Commodore, General Manager, family of injured, etc.
8. Complete an incident report

Be Prepared to tell 9-1-1

1. Current location of injured person
2. Description of boats (if requesting on-water help)
3. Where you plan to bring the person ashore (see below)
4. Age/Gender/Number of injured people
5. Type of injury/situation
6. Your name and call back number
