Note: Any ten members may nominate and file with the Secretary, prior to September 10th, one candidate for each elective office of the Club.

The election for the Board of Governors shall function as follows:

The four men receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to serve for two years. The member receiving the next highest number of votes shall be elected to serve for one year.

The Trustee elected shall serve for a period of five years.

We are informed that an amendment to the election rulings will be offered at the September meeting for action in the Spring meeting. This amendment will correct two phases of the original amendment as follows...

1. The intent of the original amendment was to qualify the fact that, following the first election, all Governors would be elected for a period of two years. In other words, five Governors would be elected this year for two years and four Governors would be elected in 1951 for two years. This would balance the Board.

However, the original amendment does not cover this phase so the new amendment will be offered as a corrective measure.

2. The second corrective amendment is designed to enable the Board to go outside the Board membership to select a Secretary-Treasurer if the emergency exists. As the amendment now reads, the Board must elect a Secretary-Treasurer within its membership, and, obviously, circumstances could develop wherein this correction would be in order.
