All of which proves that Spring is just around the corner. The days are getting longer, the pussy willows are out, big fat robins are all over the place and the plutocrats are returning from Florida.

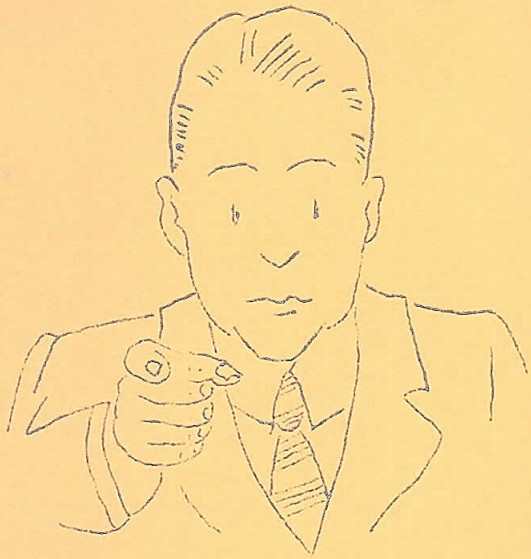

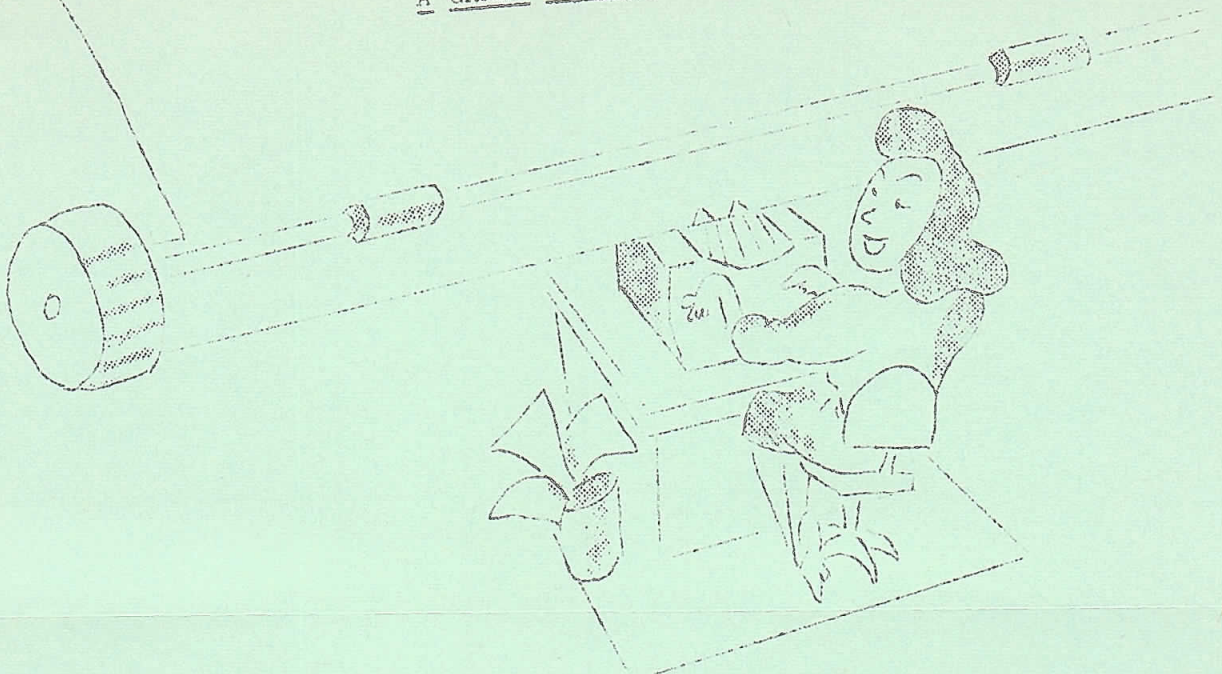
