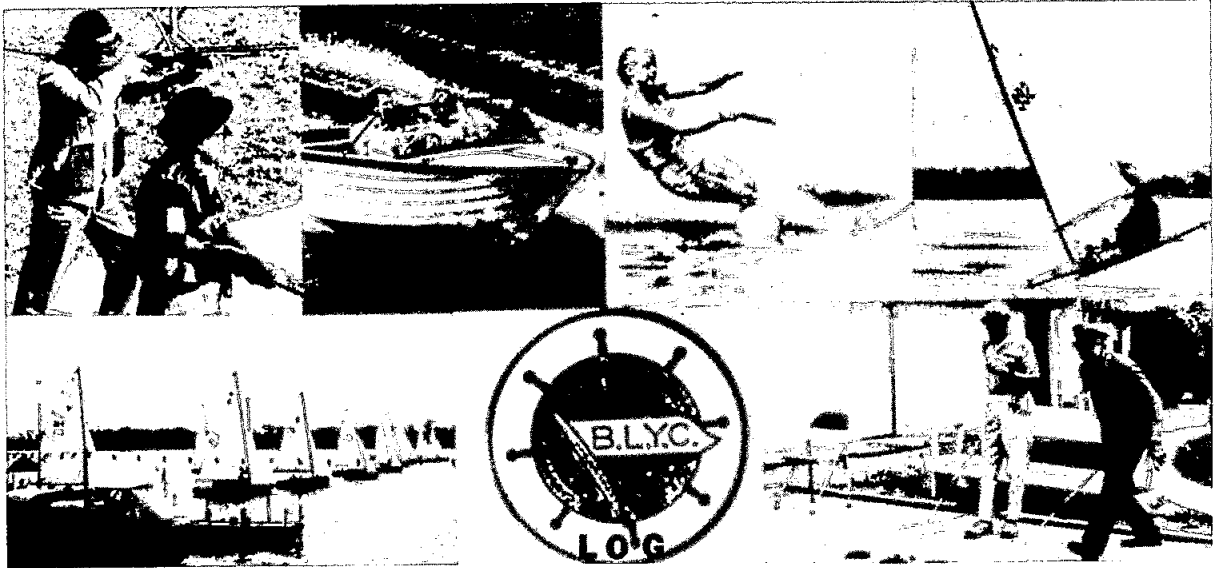

Failure to comply with this rule will automatically disqualify participant in the racing event. The enforcement of this rule is the responsibility of the Governor in charge of the Race Committee."

The secretary will notify the Fleet Captains of this action in writing. It will also be placed on the bulletin board.
