A DELICIOUS HAM DINNER WILL BE PREPARED FOR EASTER SUNDAY.





#### GUN CLUB


Another shooting year has come and gone for the BLYC Gun Club. Hopefully the 77-78 season will be blessed with milder weather and improved attendance.
