





## SAILING

The Lidos, Ventures and Lasers have started their first series with the air being relatively good except for Sunday, May 15th, when it was a question of who could outrift the other.

At the May Board Meeting, the following rules were ratified for the running of the 1977 Masters Series.

1. The series will be sailed by one representative from the Lightning, Highlander, Lido, Laser and Venture fleets predicated upon the qualifications as set forth in Number 2 hereof.
2. In order for a FLEET to qualify for participation in the 1977 Masters, that FLEET must have participated in at least 50% of the scheduled Sunday races. Consideration will be given by the Race Committee for those Sundays which are cancelled for conditions beyond our control.
3. Each FLEET will select their representatives by their own criteria.
4. The crews of the participating boats will be selected by the skippers representing each FLEET and shall be selected from persons who regularly sail in the fleet he represents.
5. The Masters Series will be sailed in Highlanders this year round robin on September 17, 18, 24, 25, 1977.
6. The Race Committee will make arrangements for the series.
7. The Race Committee will be notified of their fleet representatives by 6:00 PM on Sunday, September 11, 1977.


