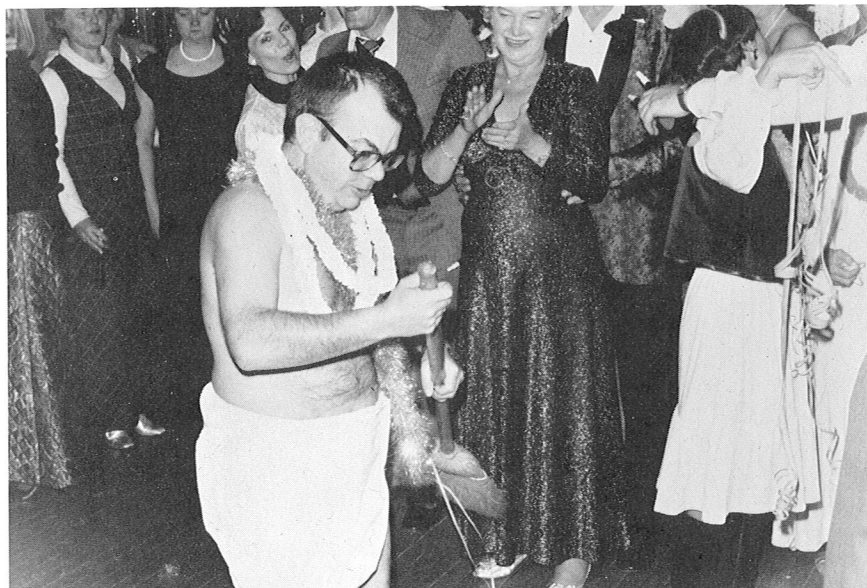

NEED CREW?

In an effort to develop interest in sailing and to make the desirability of joining BLYC known to more people, the Board of Governors is proposing a new type of membership to be known as CREW MEMBERS. At present our By Laws limit visits by male guests of members to three times in any one year. (Girls are welcome any time, Why not??) The proposed CREW MEMBERSHIP would be open to men proposed by skippers who wish them to serve as crew fairly regularly. The proposed Crew Member would have all the COMMON PRIVILEGES of a Club Member and be encouraged to participate in Club activities. For this privilege he would pay a Crew Membership dues, to be set by the Board of Governors (\$40.00 is the current proposal.) Such a trial membership would be limited to two years. The exact wording of this proposed Ammendment to the Constitution and By Laws will be published before the Spring Meeting.

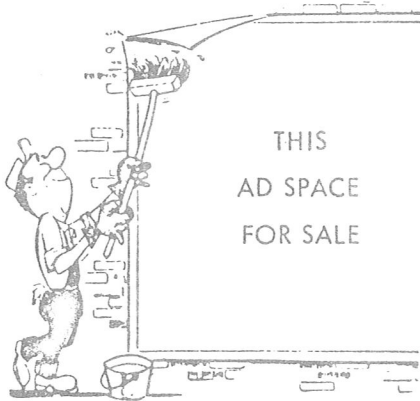
Do you have a friend who needs to know about the facilities and fellowship of BLYC? Invite him and his family out some time. Tell him to "Try it -- You'll like it". If he is to sail with you, get him a Crew Membership. If sailing is not his cup of tea, and he is under 35, he may be able to join now and pay his initiation fee later. Another proposal of your Board of Governors is to have an ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP. On that plan, a man can spread out his Initiation Fee payments until he is 35, but he does not have voting privileges until the Initiation Fee is fully paid.
