Don't forget the clubrooms are open for private parties at most all times. We need your support in inviting private organizations and clubs to use our facilities for meetings and dinners.

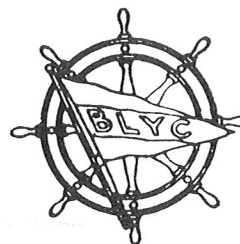
