REMEMBER--WORK DAY--Sunday April 8--Boy, do we have a lot of work this year--come out and join us WE NEED YOU!!!

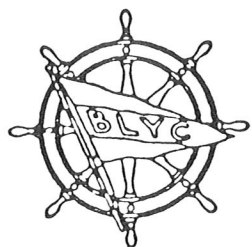

Proposed ammendment to the By-Laws, Article VIII, Section 3,  
 COMMITTEES AND THEIR DUTIES; sub paragraph C-STANDING  
 COMMITTEES, item (10) THE ENDOWMENT FUND COMMITTEE shall be  
 composed of three (3) BLYC members appointed for three year  
 terms on an over lapping basis. The Commodore shall designate  
 the chairman and appoint a replacement for the retiring  
 member or re-appoint him by Dec. 31 of each year. The  
 committee shall confer with the Trustees of the Endowment  
 Fund at least once a year and report in writing to the Club  
 membership at the Spring Semi-annual meeting and to the  
 Board of Governors at such time as the committee sees fit  
 regarding the status of the Endowment Fund. The club treasurer  
 shall be an ex-officio member of the committee. The committee  
 shall also actively solicit new perpetual members from the  
 club membership and report the names of such perpetual  
 members to the Board of Governors.
