


The April Icebreaker will be combined with the Las Vegas Night party on Saturday, April 21, 1979. I hope you all will attend as it should be a great evening.



Proposed ammendment to the By-Laws, Article VIII, Section 3, COMMITTEES AND THEIR DUTIES; sub paragraph C-STANDING COMMITTEES, item (10) THE ENDOWMENT FUND COMMITTEE shall be composed of three (3) BLYC members appointed for three year terms on an over lapping basis.
