COMMODORE GEORGE FISHER HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION TO MAKE ANY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE JUNIOR PROGRAM TAX-DEDUCTABLE. THIS SHOULD HELP OUR FUND-RAISING DRIVE TO PURCHASE ONE OF THE NEW BOATS.

NOW THAT THE WEATHER IS GETTING MORE HOSPITABLE, COME OUT AND ENJOY THE CLUB AND ONE OF JOHN'S GOOD DINNERS. THE GUN CLUB IS STILL SHOOTING EVERY SUNDAY, AND ICE BREAKERS WILL BE MEETING MARCH 19TH. AND START THINKING ABOUT GETTING YOUR BOAT READY - THE SPRING SERIES IS ONLY SIX WEEKS AWAY.

DID YOU KNOW THAT ? ? ?

The oldest Tavern in Ohio is Minthorn's on Rt.#360. It is opposite the old "Dry Dock" at the west end of the lake. The original tavern provided food and lodging for the men who dug the canal in this part of the state. The canal was started in 1825.

In 1929 there were 29 restaurants, snack bars and snack shops on the Tow Path from the Spillway to the then existing amusement park.

Sneaking of restaurants, the founder of the "Williams" restaurant that is on Rt. #79 just north of the express way over pass, had his first restaurant on the Tow Path in a building where Sayre Bros. Marine office and show room now stands.

When Buckeye Lake is full of water and just going over the "Panels" on the top of the Spillway Dam, the surface of the water in the lake is 892 ft. above Sea Level.

Our twentieth President of the United States, James A. Garfield, one of Ohio's "Jewels", who was assassinated just 16 years after President Lincoln was shot, earned part of his living as a young man, driving horses on the Canal Tow Path.

C.B. "Brownie" Cornell who was Commodore of BLYC. in 1924, was one of the architects that worked on the O'Shaughnessy Dam.

It was Comm. Cornell's brother Fred who wrote the words of "CARMEN OHIO", OSU's Alma Mater. On the trip home from Ann Arbor, where the football team of the University of Michigan had defeated Ohio State by the score of 86 to 0. He wrote the words on the back of an envelope. The year was 1902, four years before the founding of BLYC.

Helen Limes was the first president of the "Ladies Auxiliary in 1941. She was also the first president of the "Fisher, Henery, Wood" Cancer Ray, whose members are all past presidents of the "Ladies Aux.". Helen Limes is the first lady of BLYC. to have had 2 husbands and a son as Commodore of BLYC.



BY-LAWS AMENDED - CONSTITUTION CHANGES PROPOSED

The Board of Governors adopted some By-Law revisions. The revised By-Laws and the Constitution will be reprinted after the Spring Semi-Annual meeting at which the proposed constitutional amendments can be considered by the members. The following is a brief summary of the most significant changes and proposed changes. Upon request I will send anyone a copy of specific provisions.


The House, Dockage and Bar Rules have been incorporated into the By-Laws. A Life Jacket Rule was included which requires children under 12 to wear a life jacket on club property outside the club house but permits a child to be excused from this rule if the parent requests it in writing stating that the parent assumes all liability and risk and agrees to hold the club harmless. See Governor Jacobs for a written form. A list of excused children is to be posted.

The minimum age requirement for an active member was reduced to 18. Eligibility for junior membership was modified as well as qualifications for converting junior membership to active membership. A member is now entitled only to a single demit although the Board of Governors can extend it. Fees and timing for perpetual memberships is redefined.

Club boat usage is restricted to club members and their families and hoist usage is limited to 48 hours without approval of the Commodore or the Governor in Charge of slip assignments.

The proposed constitutional changes are posted at the club in detail. There are three. First, a member who was elected to the Board of Governors by the members and was elected and served a year as Rear Commodore and who was again elected to the Board by the members and was elected and served a year as Vice Commodore, would automatically become Commodore the next year. Second, the nominating committee would only be required to nominate eleven candidates for the Board of Governors if the Vice Commodore was going to automatically succeed to Commodore. Third, proposed By-Law amendments would need to be published in the Log before being considered by the Board of Governors.




LADIES AUXILLIARY
