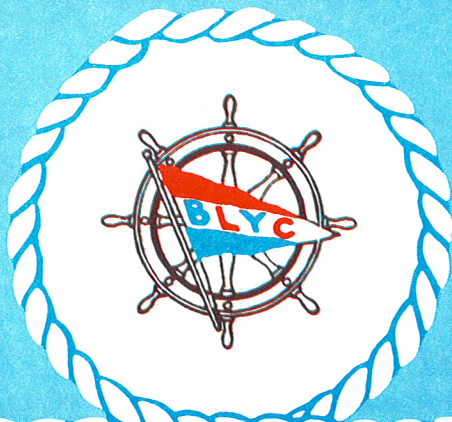



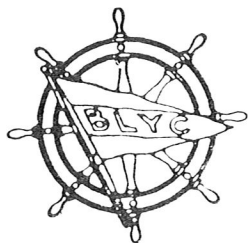

Remember to pay your Club dues before May 1st. Join us at the Club!

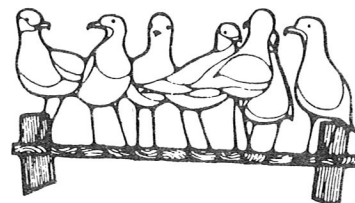

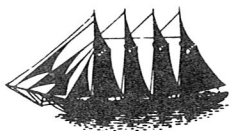
AFTER A LONG HARD WINTER IT'S TIME TO THINK ABOUT THE DOCKS.
