The July calendar merely says "Party" for July 16. Don't let that fool you. You won't believe what Mike Jacobs has come up with for July 16. Read on in this Log.

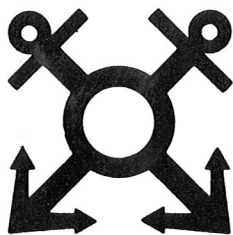
