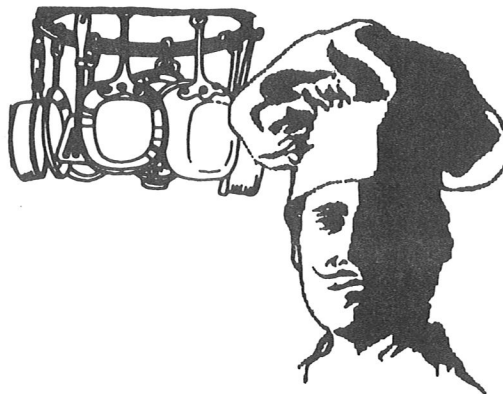
We have a good Junior Training Program to follow from the past. We have a good, new, Sailing Team to represent BLYC in 1986.

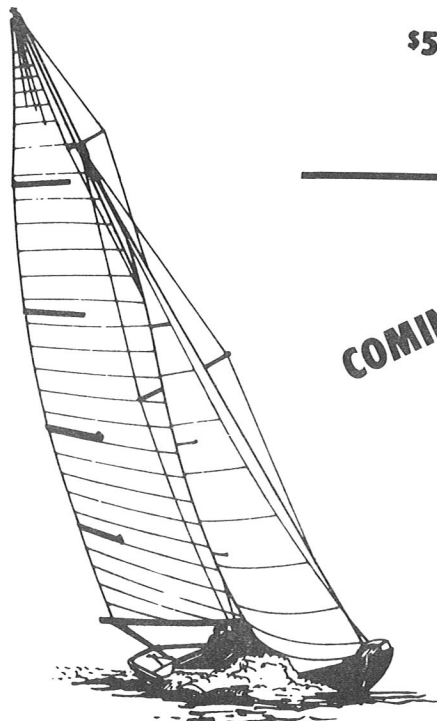

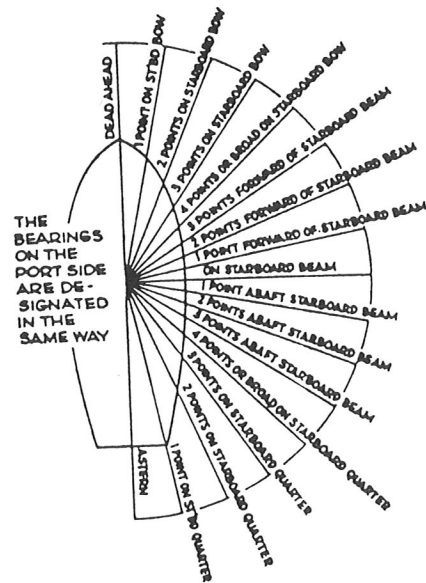
