Eight boats started. Five finished as follows:





Dear Members and Friends:

During the past twelve months, it has been my privilege to serve as your voice on the Board of Governors regarding matters concerning the condition of the Clubhouse. Without the willing support and constructive suggestions offered, my job would have been much less enjoyable and productive. My sincere thanks to all. Particular mention is made of those kind souls who appear as regularly and predictably as Spring flowers and Fall leaves for the semi-annual "Work Days". Although washing windows and polishing trophies may not describe an enjoyable Sunday's outing, the appearance and utility of the Club would suffer without your efforts.

With regard to the future, I suggest that top priority be given to a complete overhaul of the electrical system in the Clubhouse. Some of the early wiring is approaching the danger point. At best, the circuits are inefficiently laid out and present problems when maintenance is required. I believe Commodore Boehm has plans in this area. We must all give him whatever financial and physical support he needs. The alternative could be the irreplaceable loss of a treasured and historic building.

A major disappointment was the lack of time to help in finishing the Pool Dressing Room. I understand Governor Patterson has the situation well in hand and that it will be ready for the Spring 1988 pool opening. If nothing else, I have learned that Summer-time at Buckeye Lake is a poor time to undertake any job requiring more than 15 minutes concentration.




New business: Custis Wuellner suggested that the club consider buying carpeting for the club porch.


