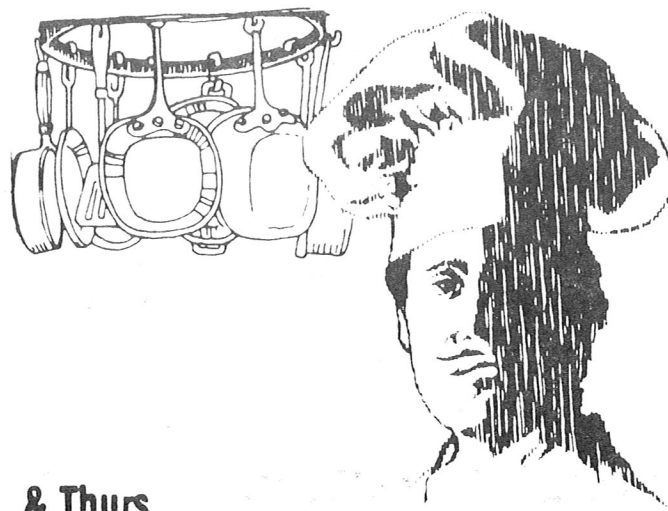

IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A BETTER METHOD FOR BOAT STORAGE AT EASTPORT, WE ARE ADOPTING THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE.

THE LOCKS ON THE GATES WILL REMAIN THE SAME. THE LOCK ON THE CABLE, ALLOWING ACCESS IN AND OUT OF THE BOAT YARD WILL BE CHANGED. WHEN YOU PAY YOUR 1988 STORAGE BILL, PAYABLE TO BLYC C/O KEITH DOTSON, YOU WILL RECEIVE A PAID RECEIPT. WHEN YOU PRESENT YOUR PAID RECEIPT TO JOHN OR CAROL DONEFF, AT THE CLUB, YOU WILL RECEIVE A NEW KEY TO THE CABLE LOCK. THIS KEY WILL BE THE SAME NUMBER AS YOUR LOT NUMBER (KEY #1=LOT #1), YOU WILL ALSO RECEIVE A 1988 IDENTIFICATION TAG. PLEASE PUT THE TAG ON YOUR BOAT OR TRAILER.

IF YOU DID NOT PAY YOUR STORAGE BILL WITH YOUR 1988 BLYC DUES, YOU MAY PAY JOHN, AT THE CLUB, AND RECEIVE YOUR NEW KEY AND I.D. TAG AT THAT TIME.

The winter is almost gone, but we did have some extensive damage to the mooring posts on the west wall as well as the south wall in front of the club. Several weeks ago, the ice on the lake began to move and when it hit our wall, the ice snapped approximately 30 4" X 4" oak posts and also damaged five bubblers. We have the repairs scheduled and new posts will be in before the season begins.

We just received a notice from the state of Ohio, with our dock license rates for 1988. Most of the docks have not been increased, but all docks that connect to state land (north bank) have been raised to \$40.00 each. They also want to charge \$40.00 each for docks on area 8, but we are now trying to get the state to reduce that fee.

Even though the Club will have to pay the increase for 1988, we will not assess the dock renters as the 1988 dock invoices have already been mailed.

For 1989 we will total all the license fees and divide the total by the number of docks. This is the fair way to distribute the increase. All docks will be charged the same amount for licenses.

As you know all dock money should have been paid by March 15, 1988. If you haven't paid yours, please do so promptly. A registered letter will be sent to those people owing dock rent. If your money is not received by April 22, 1988, you will lose your dock.

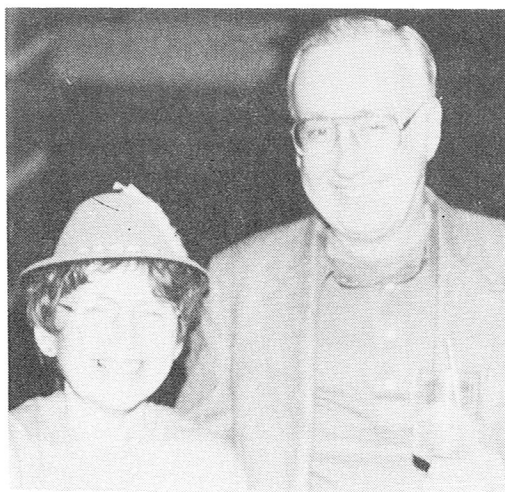
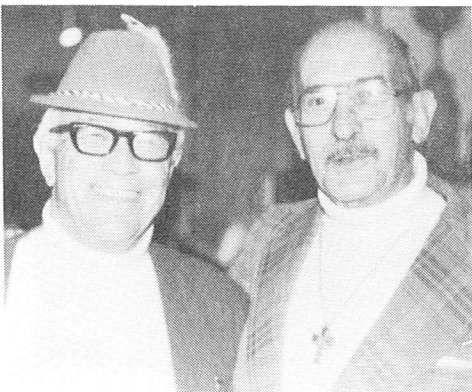

ST. PATRICK'S DAY ICE BREAKER







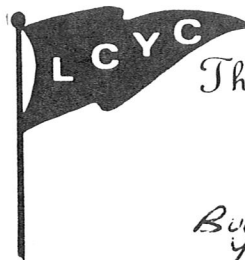

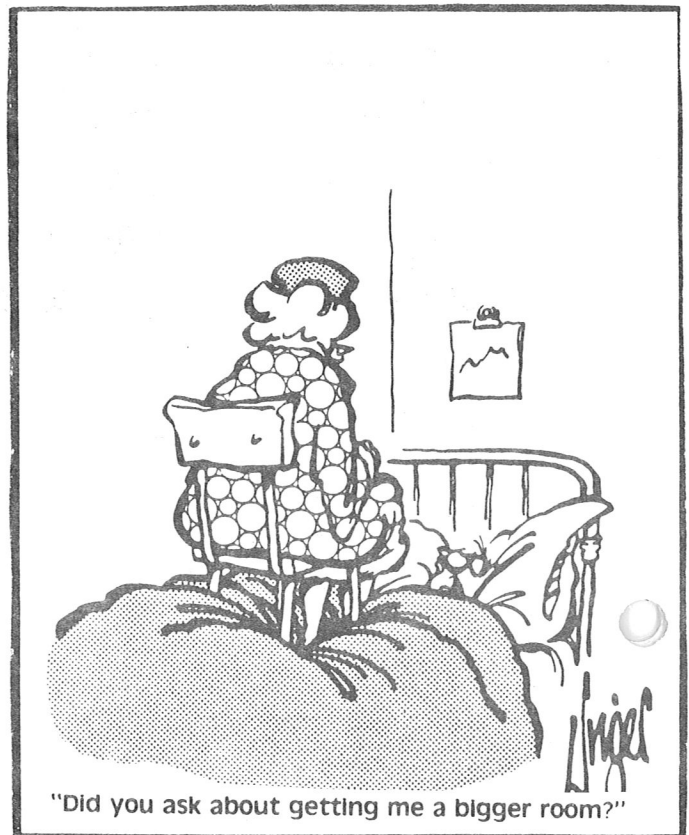
