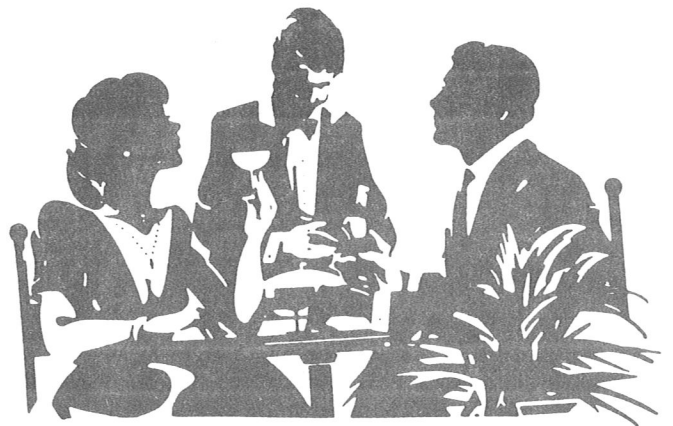

Chisty Hardy, Holly Higgins, Jennifer Forster, Mathrew Ottenweller, Kathie Dressel and Janice Foster.

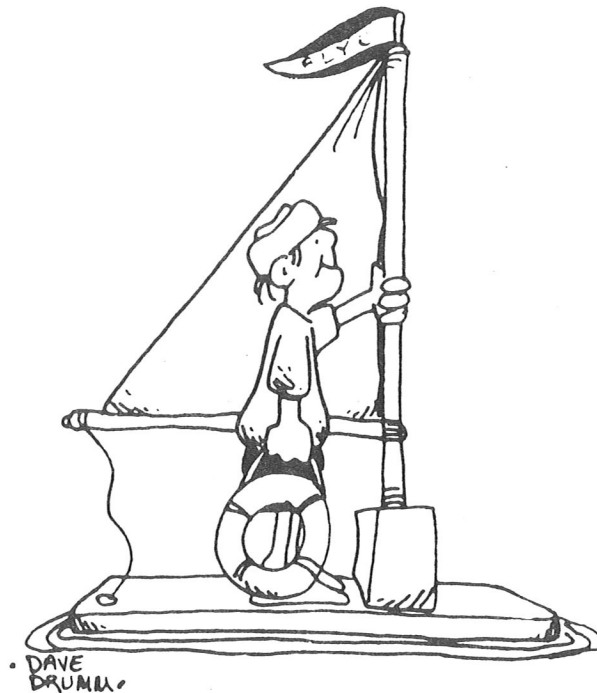
Bay-Week stand outs were Kathy Dressel and Jennifer Forster.

The Club is very proud of each of you. Keep up the Good Work!

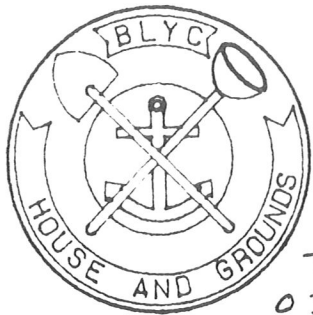


Sailing camp had 62 entries. During the 5 weeks we met many new faces, giving us a wealth of new sailing talent.

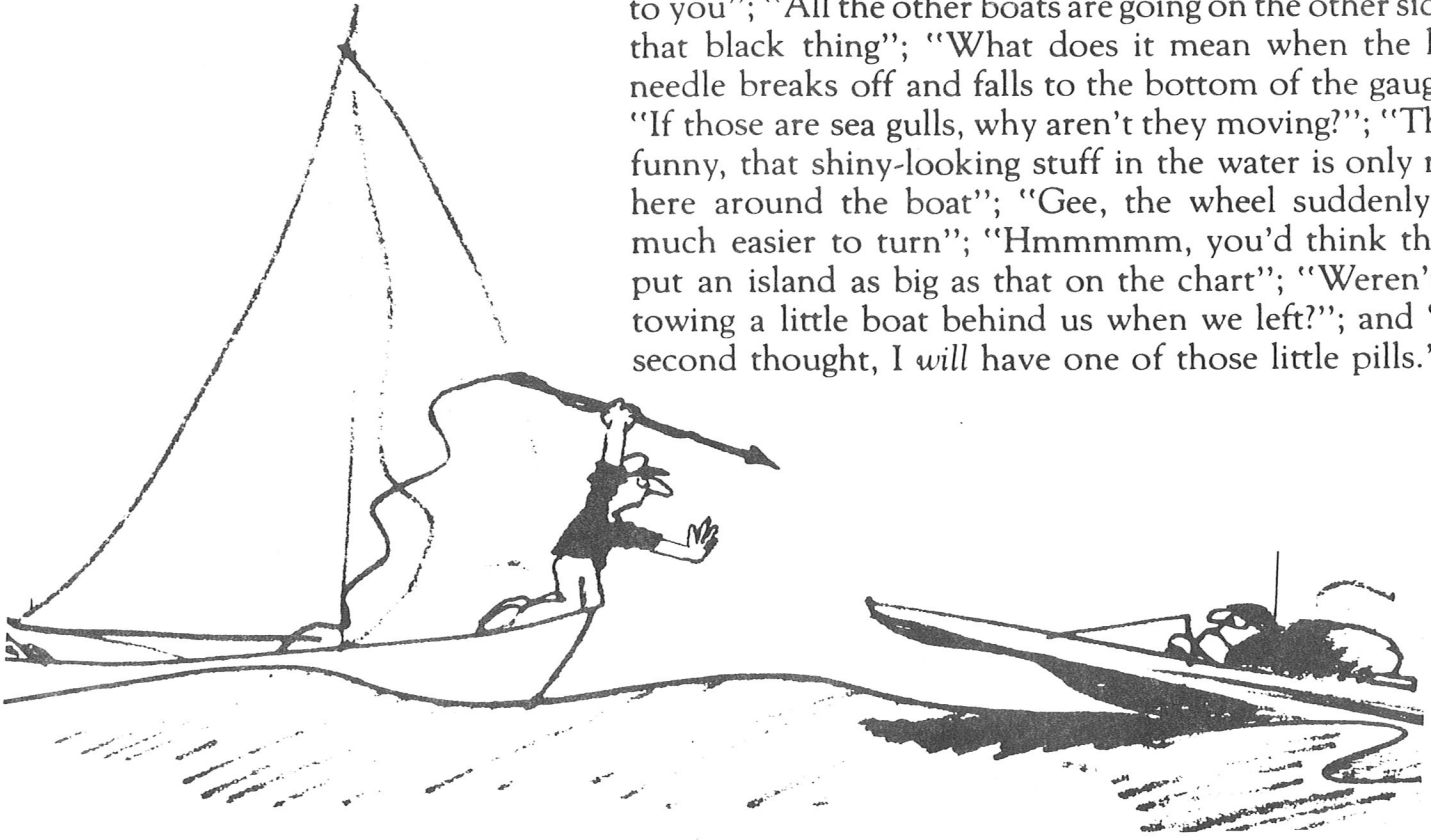




FROM THE EDITOR

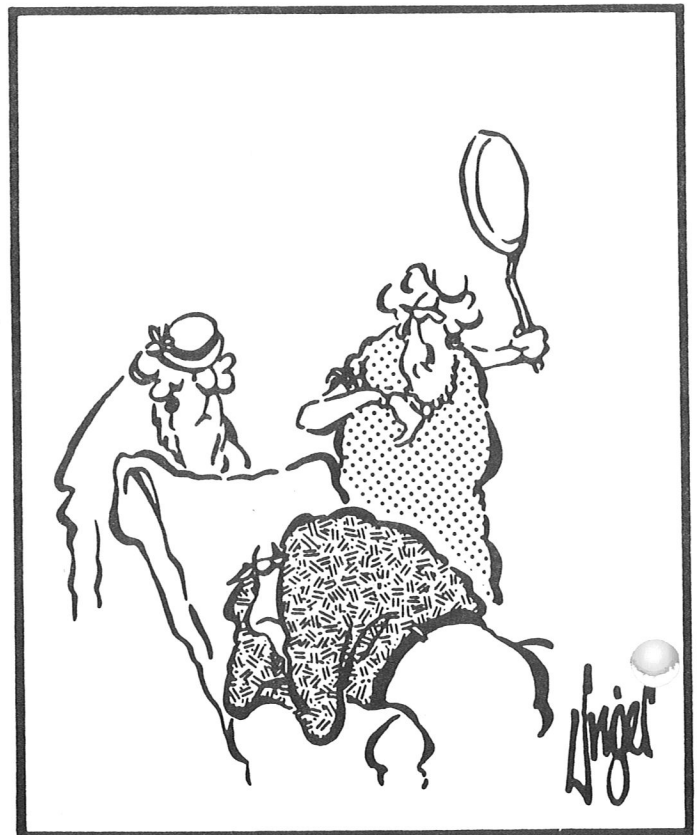
