Next months Eastport page in the Log will include a boatyard platt, showing who is where.

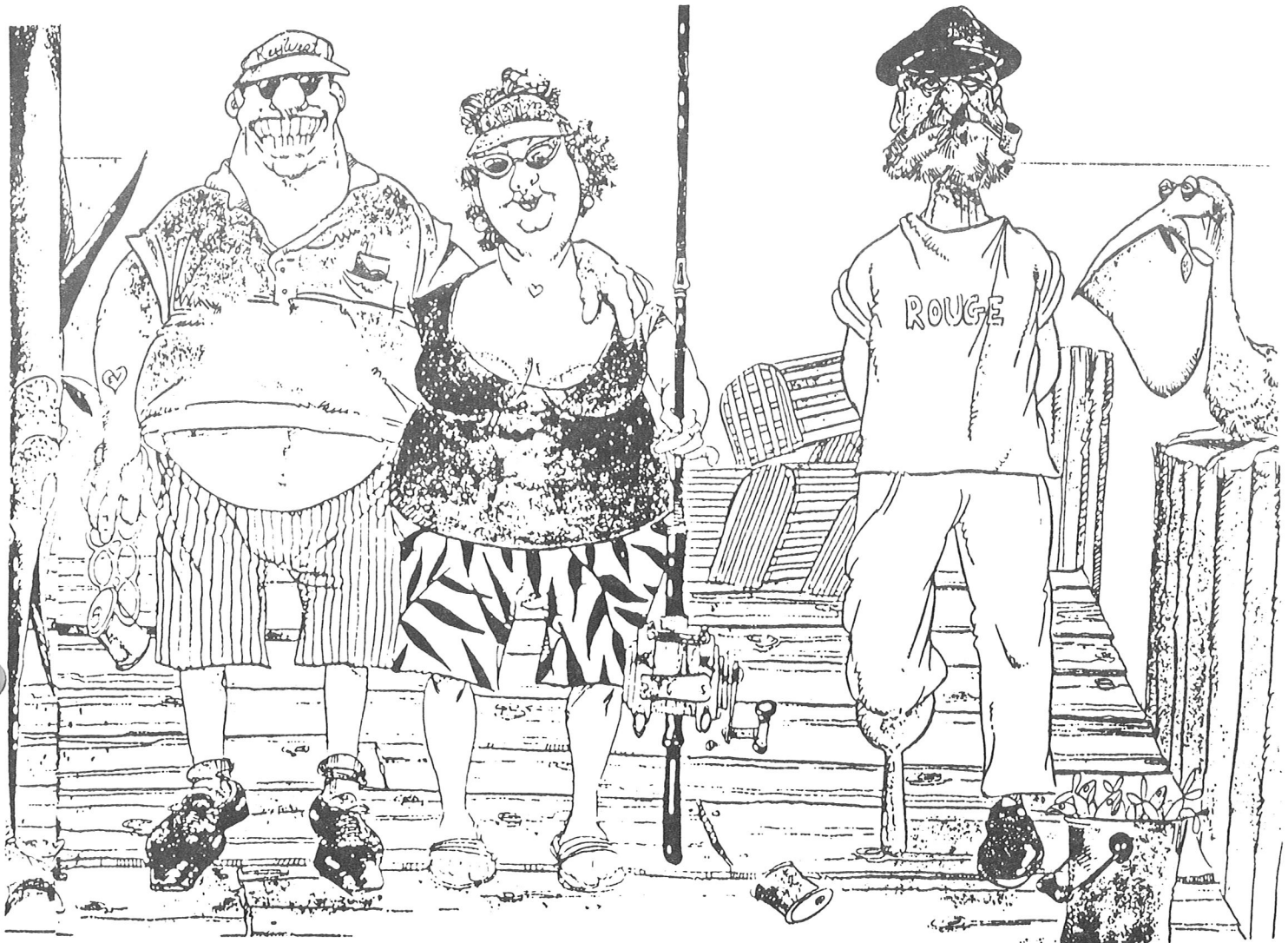
