AND PRIVILEGES OF GUESTS

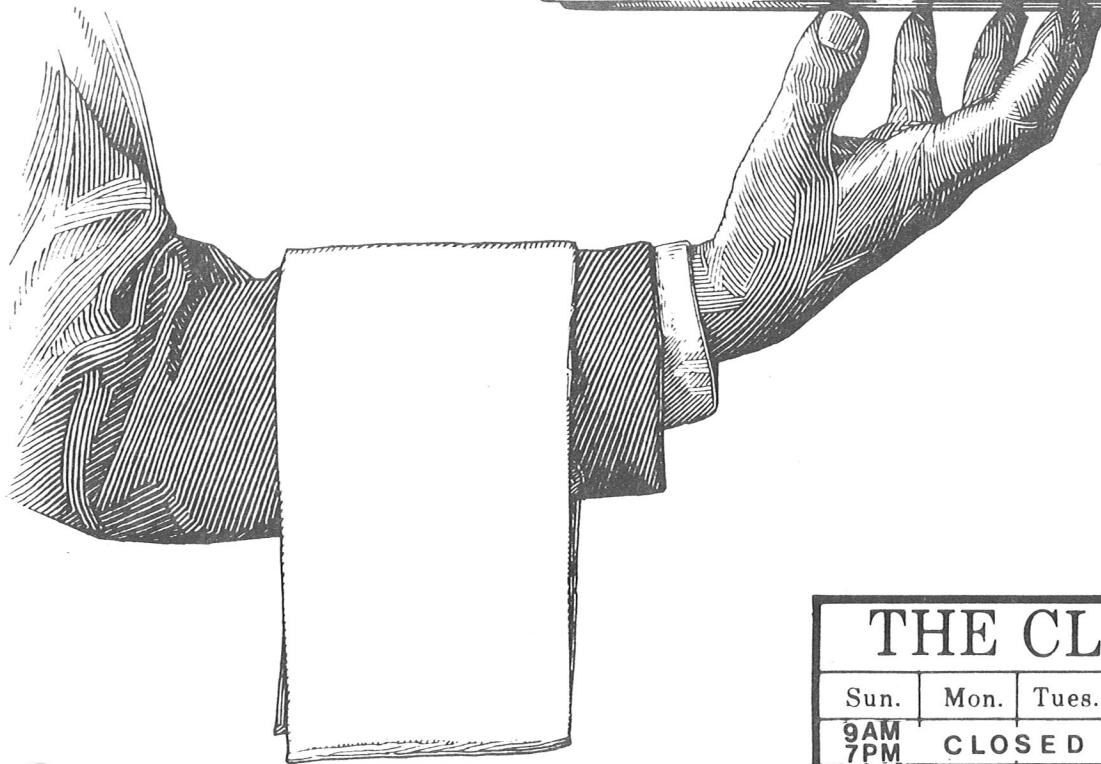
