The pool is reserved for members and guests over 18 years old on Friday and Saturday night after 6:00 p.m.


Please "pitch in" and help keep our beautiful pool area just that way -- Beautiful!

Ahoy Boaters,

The lake is up and most of you have your boats in the water are enjoying our beautiful lake. If you don't have your boat in...what are you waiting for?

I would not have believed it back in September when I assumed my present responsibilities and a very long dock waiting list, but I am very happy to report that, with the exception of those members waiting for a covered dock, everyone who has requested a dock either has one or has refused one offered. There are a few people on the list who have docks but remain on the list for a particular dock or for a more desirable one.


At the moment, there are three docks available for rental. They are: (1) #1, which is next to the bridge and on the towpath, which will accommodate a small boat with a 6' beam or less; (2) #6--also on the towpath, which can accommodate up to an 18' boat with a beam of 7'4" or less; and (3) #117--at Eastport--which can accommodate just about any size boat, except some houseboats, that you're likely to have on Buckeye Lake. Please let me know if you can use one of these docks.

When you leave our slice of paradise on earth, please make sure that you have your boat properly secured, with good mooring lines. I have had several occasions already this year to either retie a line to a mooring post or to rejoin a broken line. Have a great summer!
