



The Breakwater ran right through what is now the middle of the swimming pool. The tree to the right of the chimney might be the big beautiful old tree which overhangs the pool now. Probably the only living thing there from that far back. You can also see the back side of the old clubhouse and the boathouses connected to the north of it. Of course the building wasn't really completed until Comm. Greg Alspach added the finishing touch by adding the genuine nautical flashing light to the cupola.

Vice President Terry Kochensparger informed us that next month's meeting will be a style show featuring different ways to wear scarves. Guests will be most welcome.



