


FROM THE BRIDGE ☆☆☆







The comic strips on this page superbly illustrate one aspect of our life at BLYC which, of course, is that one usually needs to refuel regardless of the type of boat you operate!



Ryan Eisert sailed the Thistle.




The first sail-off races were raced, but had to be cancelled because the first boat didn't finish within an hour as required by the rules. However, the kids sailing the races are as follows:


