Greeting you for this event will be Maxine and Jim McBride and Chuck and Charla Bortz.

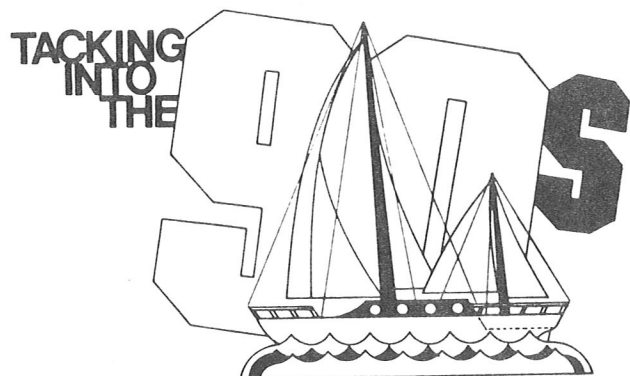

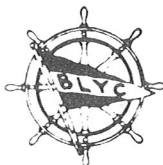
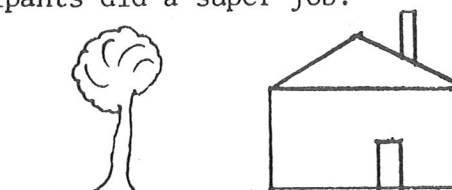

As last year, we'll start issuing new gate and cable keys around March 1. A new key comes with evidence of your paid annual statement.

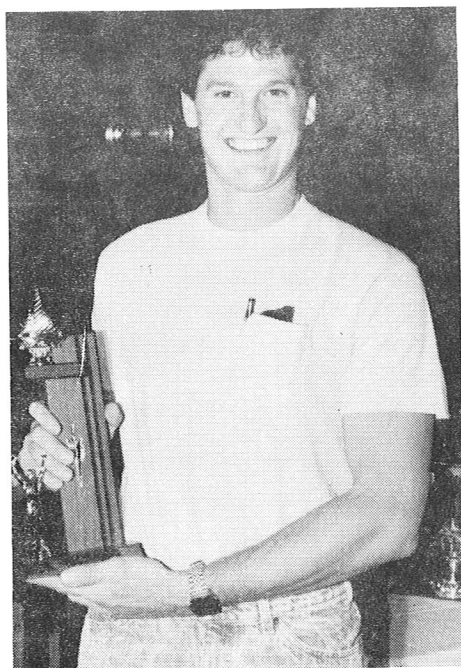
