The Ohio Department of Natural Resources is constructing a new lake spillway. This spillway, to be located at the Northwest corner of the lake, will allow for more precise and predictable control of lake water level. In preparation for this work, all property owners adjacent to state-owned park land are advised that such work could effect personal property located on park land. In the Club's case, this covers anything located on or in the land from the seawall to the north edge of the waterfront sidewalk. As we anticipate making major repairs to the island bridge surface and the parking lot ramp this spring, coordination will be necessary with the State's plans as well as keeping you informed of temporary traffic problems.
