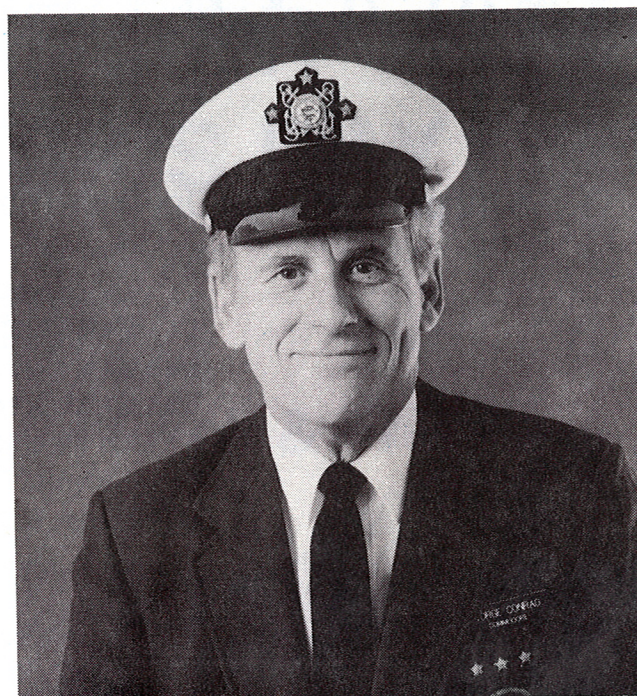

LOCAL BOY MAKES GOOD DEPARTMENT:

The winter issue of Mid-America Boating has a nice article about Gus Schell. Among other things, it recounts the early days of Schell Scenic Studios where Gus worked for his father Gus Sr. in charge of the paint brush cleaning department (Work Day Governor please note). Gus has been active in many social and community organizations over the years. He has ably represented the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club as our delegate to and Commodore of (1975) the Inter-Lake Yachting Association. The Ohio Department of Natural Resources is constructing a new lake spillway. This spillway, to be located at the Northwest corner of the lake, will allow for more precise and predictable control of lake water level. In preparation for this work, all property owners adjacent to state-owned park land are advised that such work could effect personal property located on park land. In the Club's case, this covers anything located on or in the land from the seawall to the north edge of the waterfront sidewalk. As we anticipate making major repairs to the island bridge surface and the parking lot ramp this spring, coordination will be necessary with the State's plans as well as keeping you informed of temporary traffic problems.

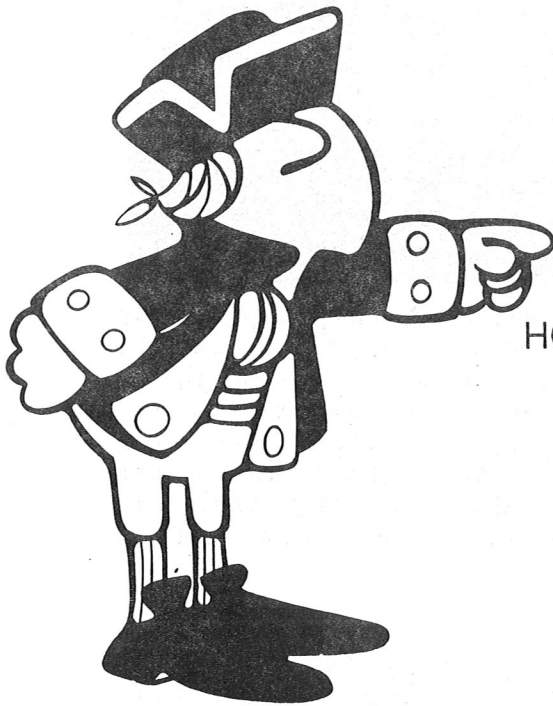

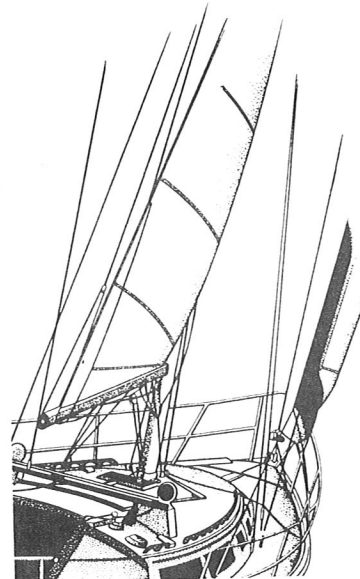
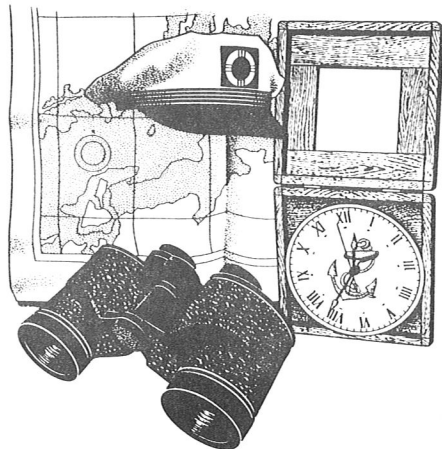

Winter (next) is closer than you think!

Yes, it's getting closer and closer. The week-long Bahamas cruise that Frank Foster and I are organizing is beginning to take shape! As I've reported previously, there is a sign-up sheet indicating interest in this cruise posted on the bulletin board at the Club. At the present (as my words are "flowing" laboriously to this paper), there are thirty-three people who have indicated an interest in taking the cruise. I am in contact with Captain Joe Gherardi of Amarok Sailing Charters in Miami, who is busy lining up boats.

Although firm figures aren't available now, it would appear that the cost, which includes all meals aboard (incidentally, they were absolutely great on our last cruise) will be approximately \$450 per person, exclusive of transportation. On our last cruise, approximately one half of the group made their own arrangements in getting to and from Miami, while the rest of us flew as a group from Port Columbus. At this stage, we don't know the cost of airfare, but if purchased early and as a group, a reasonable cost can be expected. By the time you read this, I will probably have contacted the people currently on the list with specifics as to both the cost of the cruise and airfare costs.

If you aren't on the list, you should let me or Frank Foster know of your interest -- immediately. Once again, the cruise is scheduled for December 26, 1990 through January 1, 1991, and is open to sailors and non-sailors alike.

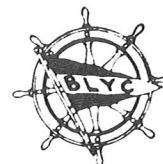

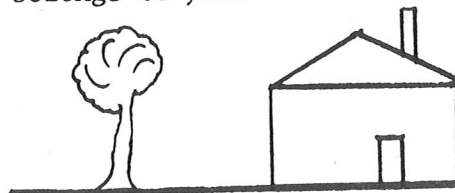
New Years Eve was a good time had by all. No one broke any house windows or tore off any siding. (Keeps The Budget Down)
