is worth two in the bush!" With that old adage in mind, the original plan for the *Tween the Trees Cruise* has been revised. As many of you know, the Muskingum River has not been open to boat traffic all the way to Marietta for several years due to repair work on some of the locks. That work is scheduled to be completed this summer with completion of work on the lock at Stockport by August 1st. We cannot, however, receive a guarantee that this lock will, in fact, be open then. With that possibility in mind, we developed "Plan B" which we are now putting into effect. This scenario means that we go to Charleston, West Virginia, instead. We will put in the water on the Ohio River at Pomeroy or Middleport on a Friday afternoon or early evening and leave early Saturday morning, going downriver to the Kanawha River, then *upriver* to Charleston. We will stay overnight Saturday in Charleston and return on Sunday.

Although the exact date has not yet been determined, we hope to have that finalized soon. Fleet Navigator Homer Tussing, Mary Lou, Maxine and I will be going to Charleston soon to arrange for docking, dining, and accommodations (for those who require them). After that, hopefully we can set a final date for what should be a great weekend. If you aren't signed up yet, there's still time. Just add your name to the list at the Club.

On another subject, the BLYC Cruising Fleet has just completed its 1990 racing schedule, which will be posted on the Bulletin Board. This year, the schedule is somewhat different. Instead of the usual weekly Sunday races, the schedule has been changed to include Saturday races as well, but essentially on a basis of every other week.

In connection with Club Racing, I'm looking for members to serve on the Race Committee. If any of you would like to help—please let me know.
