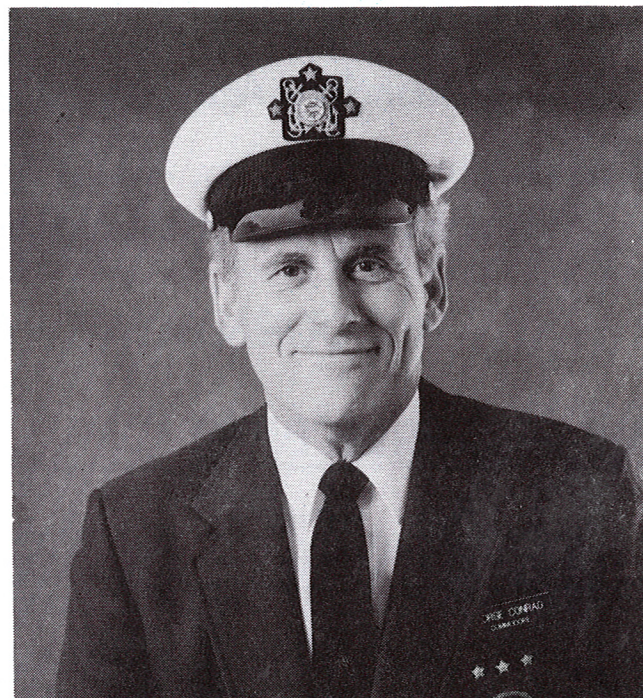

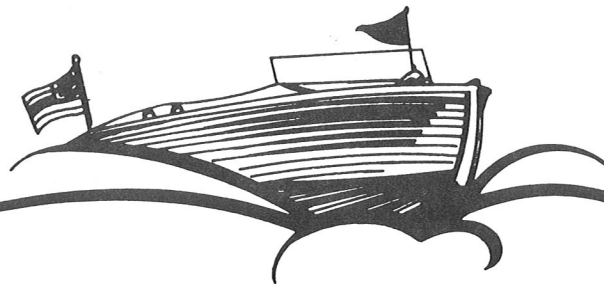

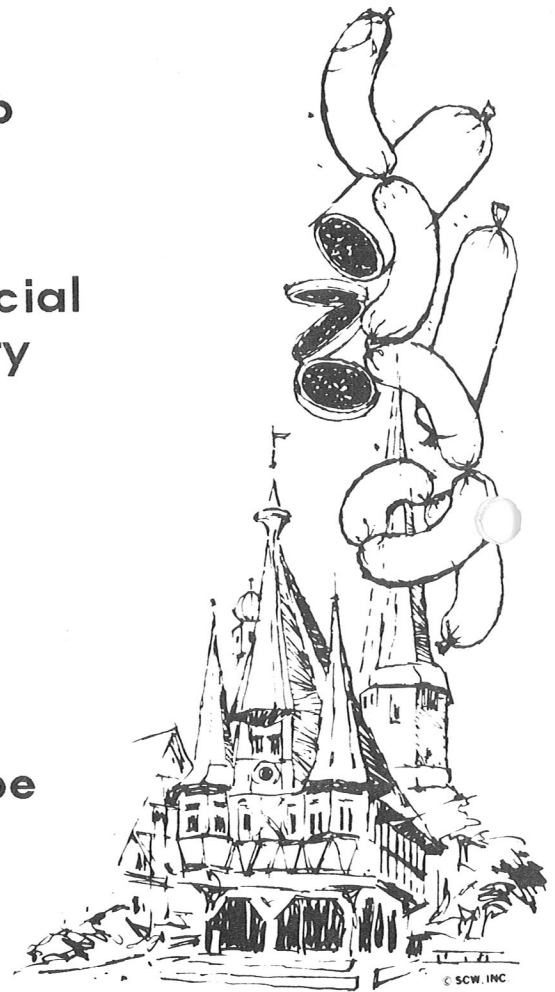

# JUNIORS

## JUNIOR SAILOFF

Your opportunity to earn the privilege of representing BLYC during Jr. Bay Week in the summer of 1991 at Put-In-Bay will begin August 11, 1990. In the traditional manner, juniors will race in Lasers in accordance with the published rules for that purpose to determine who will represent Buckeye Lake in each of three series. See Comm. Frank Foster, Junior Governor, for a copy of those rules. The one hour time limit has been extended by the Board of Governors to one and one half hours.

The first race will be at approximately 10:00 A.M. on Saturday morning, August 11. The Skippers' meeting will be at 9:30 A.M. Boats should be rigged and ready to launch before the Skippers' meeting. You will receive more detailed scheduling information at the Skippers' meeting.

Races will be held both days of each weekend until the series is completed, weather permitting. Races will be run in the weather conditions specified by the rules in the first two weekends. If the series is not completed in the first two weekends it will be completed in the third weekend regardless of air, so long as the lake is safe.

To be eligible to represent BLYC at the Bay you must have a 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th or 17th birthday in 1991.

If you have any questions, please contact Gov. Frank Foster.

The Junior Sailoffs are not only an opportunity to sail and to represent BLYC, but are themselves an enjoyable series of races for juniors. You are encouraged to participate to win if you are an older junior and to gain valuable experience if you are younger.
