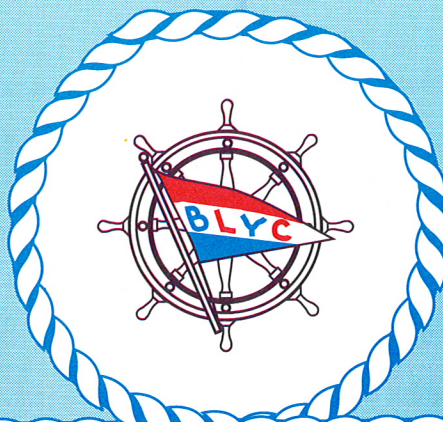

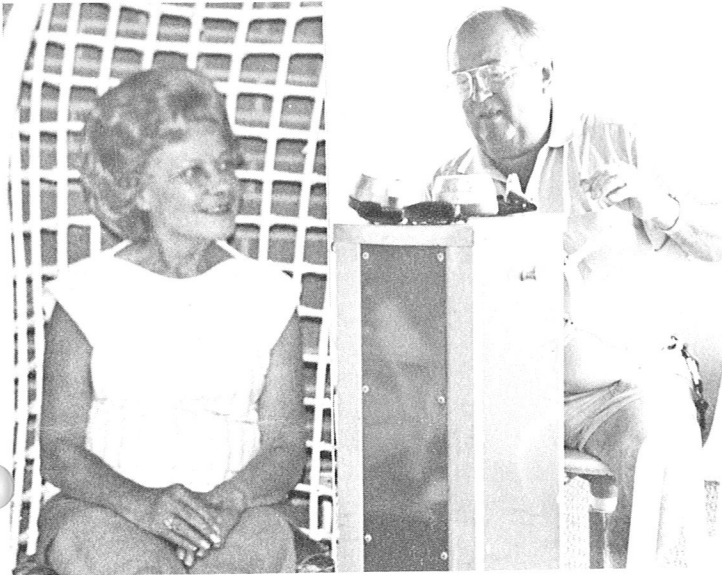

He was also Vice President of Anchor Hocking in Lancaster, where he and his wife reside. His sponsors were Henry Falken and Don Wendel, Jr.

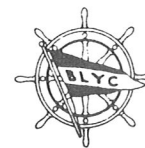
