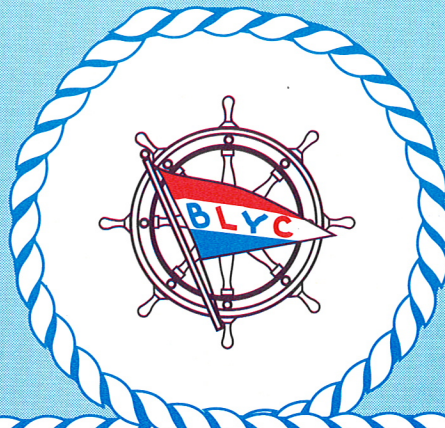

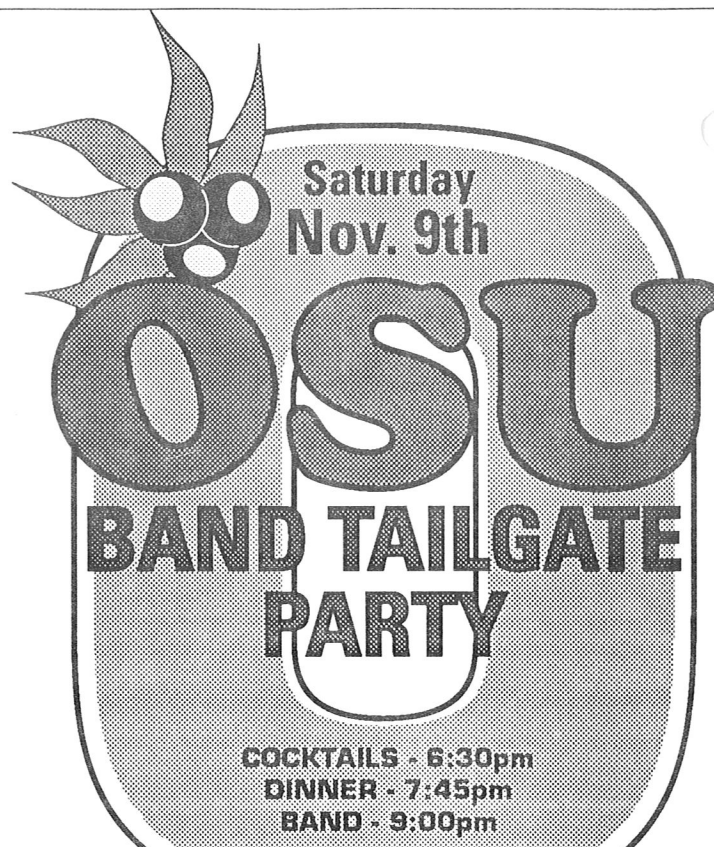
A new lighting project will be tried this Spring for our new step walk and of course other ongoing projects will naturally be continued.
