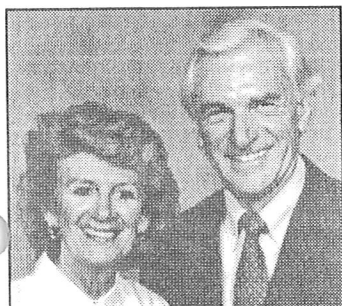
MEMBERSHIP DIRECTORY
