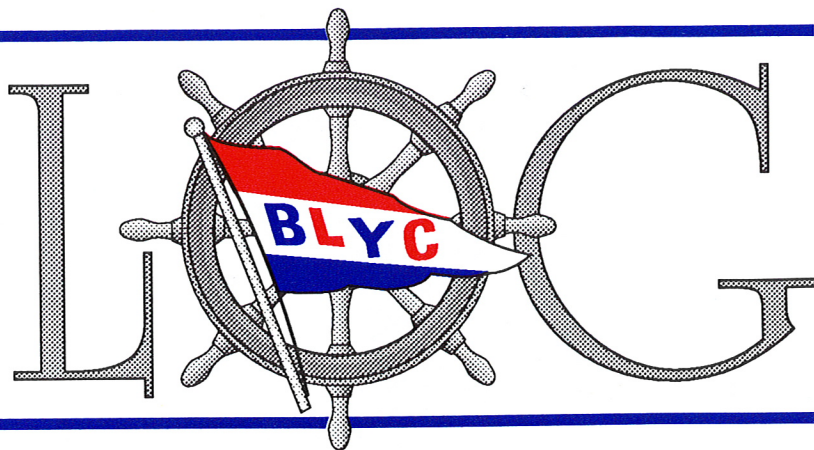

RACE AND REGATTA & JR. TRAINING

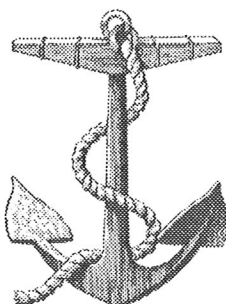
June 21 - 25 inclusive - Advanced and Intermediate
