



RACE AND REGATTA & JR. TRAINING

hairpersons for the Snowball Regatta are Walter C. Grubb and his son, Walter S. The event this year will be on October 2 and 3 at our Club's facilities. More about this later as the plans become more organized.

The Chairperson for the Antique Boat Show is Bill Hoermle and it will be held at BLYC on August 20th and 21st, 1993.

The Jr. Sailing Glass instructors have been hired for the summer. They are Chad Headlee as head instructor (same instructor



as last year) and Justin Chambers as an assistant and teen instructor. The four weeks of classes are as follows:

June 21 - 25 inclusive - Advanced and Intermediate June 28 - July 2 inclusive - Beginners July 5 - July 9 inclusive - Beginners July 12 - 16 inclusive - Only if the other dates are filled.

If enough adults are interested in learning to sail, we will be proposing one adult class to be held on Wednesday evenings and the other adult class to be held on Thursday evenings. These classes will start at 6:00 p.m. and last until dark for the four weeks, starting June rd and 24th and ending July 14th and 15th. 
