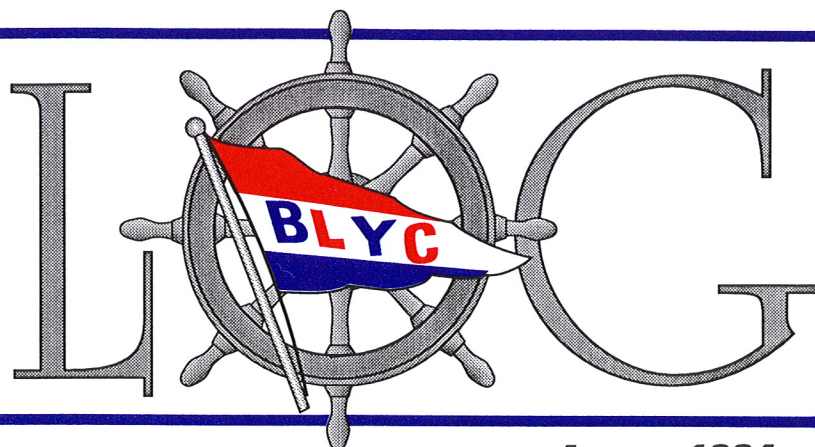


# Buckeye Lake Yacht Club

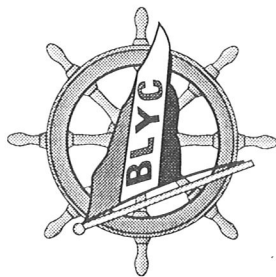
