

I want to express my appreciation to the Board of Governors and Trustees for giving me the opportunity to continue to serve the Club and our members as General Manager.

Hopefully, my past management experience and knowledge of the Club will enable me to successfully raise our level of member service(s), coordinate facility/property maintenance, maintain and elevate the level/standards for daily housekeeping and cleanliness, cost effectively provide for staffing, coordinate all daily service-delivery efforts including events and parties, and work closely with our Governors to insure that all initiatives and activities are coordinated in an efficient and businesslike manner.
