

Private Parties

Due to the fact that private parties have become a major concern of the membership, the Board of Governor's have made several changes in the private party policies which we feel will improve the use of The Club by you the members.

Private Party Policies

- 1. All private parties will be held on Wednesdays through Sunday's only, with the exception of holidays.
- 2. The pool will be off limits to all private parties.
- 3. There will be a limit of 4 hours on all afternoon parties.
- 4. Number of parties per month must be determined and approved by The Board.
- 5. The maximum number of guests, days or evenings will be 150.
- 6. All private parties are to be sponsored and attended by an active member who will be responsible for full payment

and any damage to the facility.

- 7. Civic Groups Chamber of Commerce, Historical Society etc. will be accepted.
- 8. A Master Card, Visa, or American Express Card may be used when booking the party. 30 percent down will be required at the time of booking, 50% non-refundable. The balance will be paid immediately at the end of the party with check, cash or added on their charge card.
- 9. If any extra charges are incurred for tables, chairs or linen, they will be paid by the member having the party.
- 10. There will be a \$3.00 per person facility fee.
- 11. There will be a charge for the use of the tent. \$50.00 if the tent is already up, or \$100 if assembly is necessary.
- 12. All private parties will use the portable bar when possible (60 guests or less) expenses of the bartenders will be incurred by the parties involved.
- 13. On larger parties (60-150) a reasonable portion of the bar will be allocated to the private party. The remaining 75% of the bar will be for member use only. This area will be well defined.






