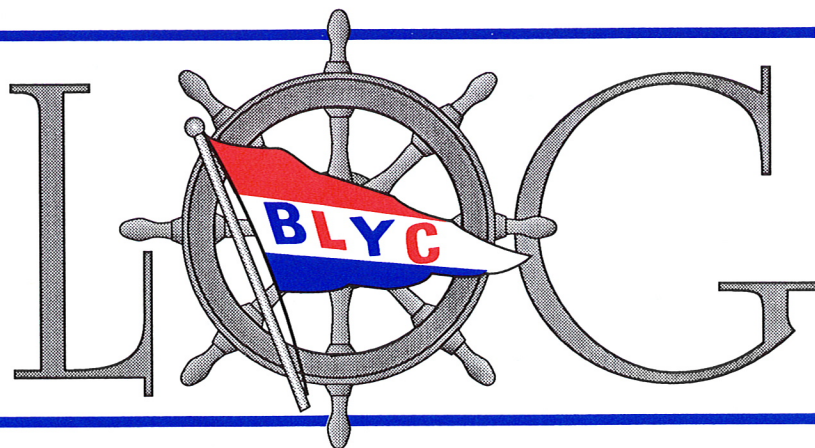

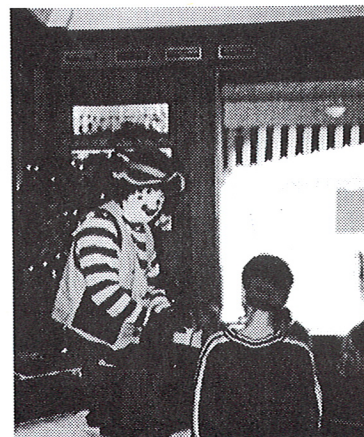
sleep with Santa?" The answer was, "Of course I do." The little girl then responded, "I thought so, 'cause my mommy and daddy sleep together, too."
