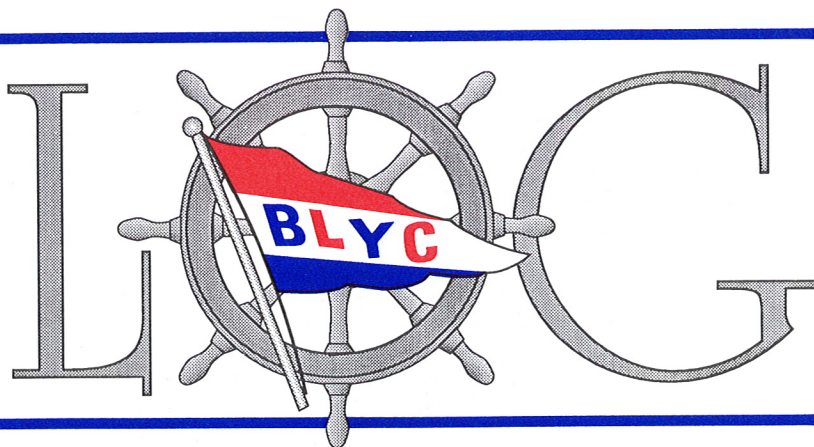

Flying Scot Class

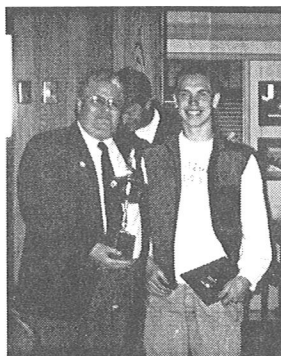
There were only two boats in this class, so trophies were not awarded. However, the results were as follows:

- Best of Season Bob Snow, Jr.

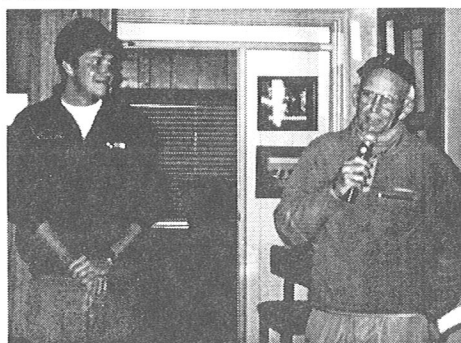
Michael R. Hein II Perpetual Trophy



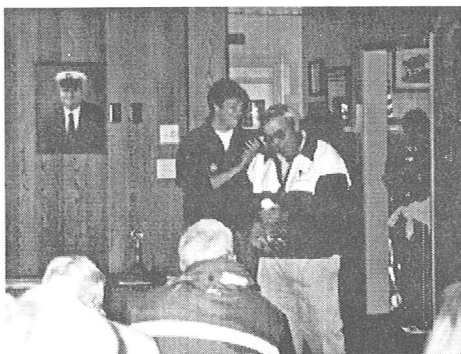
BLYC Jr. Champion Cameron Evans
