

easons Greetings! By now most of you know that East Port boat yard is one of my many offisland jobs. Well, Governor Don Lemmon we have had an



ongoing problem and I will try to explain as best as I can. Back where our boat lift is located, there is a large area that members use to put their boats in and out of the lake. Members also use this area many times during the year to lift their boats on and off of their trailers to work on them. We need this area free from obstruction, which includes trailers, boats, cars, and just misc. stuff.

This no parking area begins at the entrance; left of the entrance is a cable, no parking from the cable to west fence. Boats and trailers parked in this area must be moved to a leased assigned spot. Please remove all items in this area within the next 30 days. Failure to respond to this request will make it necessary for the Board of Governors to make necessary arrangements to relocate any items left in this no-parking area. There are no assigned spots in this area.

Our intent is to make this area available to all members to be used as intended with no obstructions. Signs will be posted in the near future to clearly mark the problem area.
