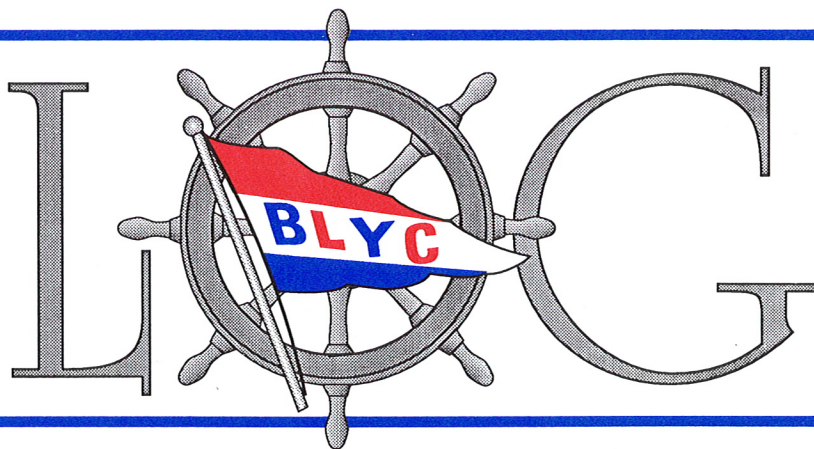

The new furnace and air conditioning unit that serves the Commodore's Lounge has been installed and is working heartily.

We have received bids on a new hot water heating system. Our old one is evidently on its last legs and we're exploring a few options as to replacement.

The engineer's recommendations, with regard to the deck separating from the pool wall will probably lead to some significant expenditures in the spring. It appears that the wall will have to be shored up from the water side to prevent further deterioration.

Nature paid us a strong visit on the night of December 11th when it blew the ice into that same deck, damaging eight of the posts. Emergency repairs have been done to stabilize the deck until further repairs can be made.

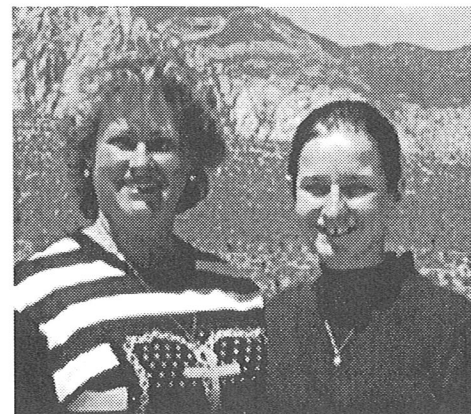

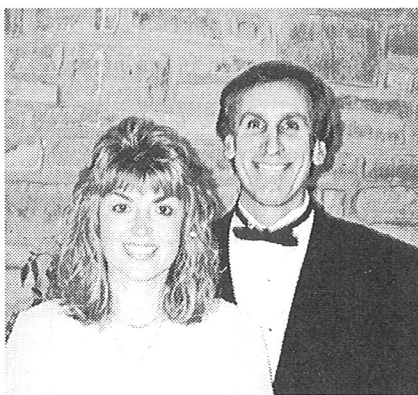
At our last Board meeting on December 14th, 2000 we had the second reading on four new members. I would like to introduce the following members:
