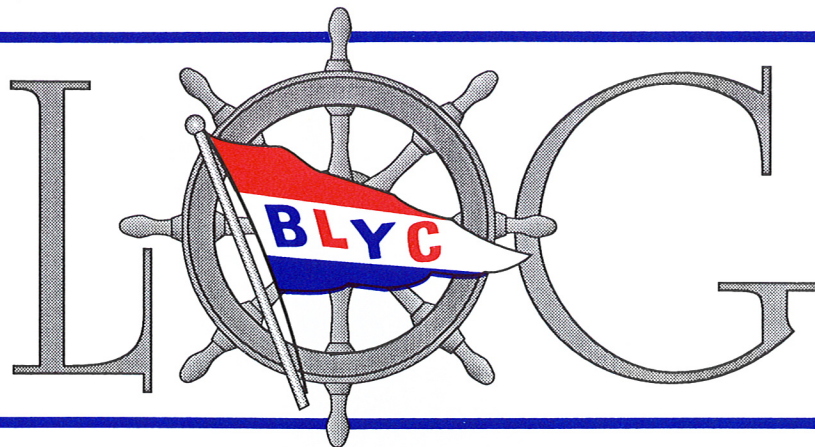

forward their winter mailing address to the Club. This will help ensure that there is no disruption in receiving the Log.

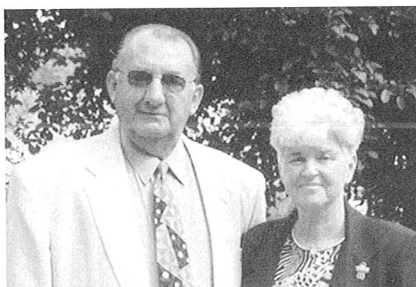
