




I would like to thank Dick Miller for repairing our mantel clock in the hearth room that we all missed.



BLYC Junior Sailing Profiles...



Mike Hein America's Cup Sailor

Mike Hein, II, son of Commodore Mike & Joan Hein, began his sailing career at the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club in 1968 when he began taking sailing lessons at the age of five from another great BLYC Junior Sailor, Greg Fisher. Mike sailed for BLYC throughout his youth, attending Junior Sailing Camp each year, and representing the Club at I-LYA Junior Bay Week four times. His first two seasons (1976-77), Mike crewed for the Bemis Trophy (2 man boat) team. The 1977 team won the Bemis Trophy Quarterfinals at Bay Week and went on to take 2nd place in the semi-finals. His final two seasons, Mike was a member of BLYC's Sears Cup Team (three-man boat – Thistle). In 1978, the BLYC team was leading during the qualifiers with four first place finishes. On the fifth race, however, their centerboard broke and they ended up finishing 6th overall, knocking them out of the quarterfinals competition. They went on to win the Commodores' Series with all 1st place finishes.

When Mike was 13, his parents bought him a Lightning. In 1982, at the age of 18, Mike and his crew won the Junior North American Lightning Championships and sailed at the Lightning World Championships in 1983. In 1985, he accepted a position as the Head Sailing Instructor for the San Diego Yacht Club. It was while working at SDYC that Mike met America's Cup skipper, Dennis Conner. Mike made the 1987 America's Cup Team and crewed (mastman) on America³ in 1992, when they won. During that time, he crewed for the Maxi World Championships six times (1986-1991) and was part of the winning Matador 2 crew in 1990 and 1991.

Mike and his wife, Annie, currently live in Aukland, New Zealand, where he works as the Captain of a 145-foot boat. Mike is a member of the San Diego Yacht Club and this year was given an honorary membership to the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club. Mike's mother, Joan Hein, is a member of BLYC along with both of his sisters and their husbands, Tracey (Matt) Davis and Barb (Drew) Loring. Mike's sister, Tracey, is still very actively involved with the Junior Sailing Program at BLYC.
