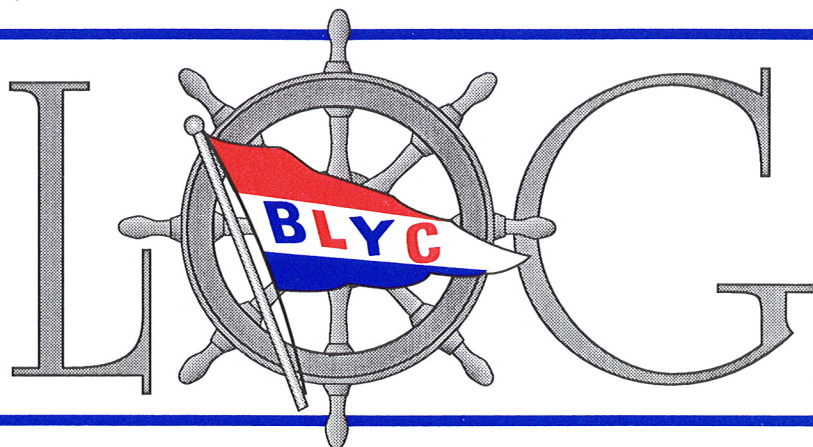



3. Change the governing year of the Auxiliary to a January-to-January calendar schedule from the current

September-to-September... pg. 3, Art VI, Sec. 5

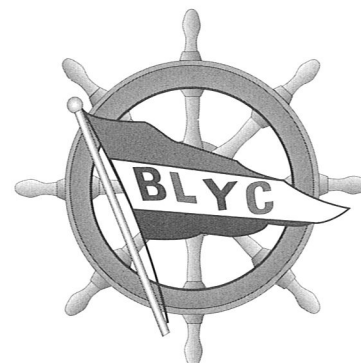

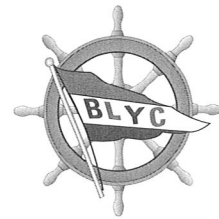
Just a reminder, Junior Sailing Camp will be here before you know it. Please register as soon as you can so instructors can be scheduled.

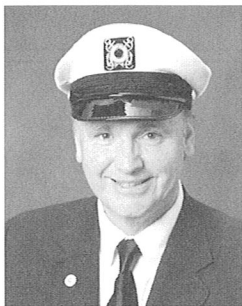

George Fisher Receives U.S. Sailing's Sportsmanship Award

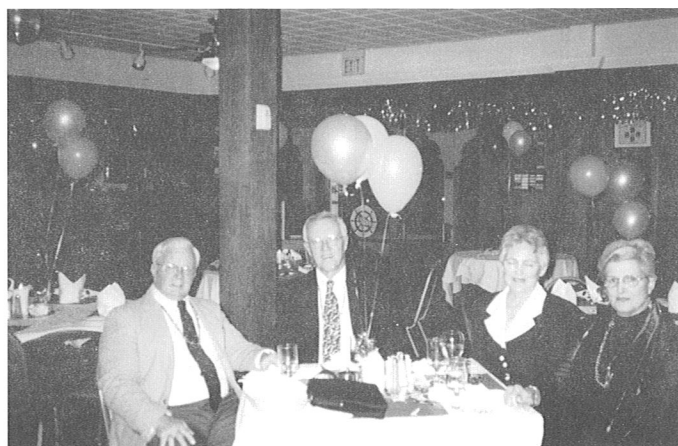
