

Commodore Gus Schell (BLYC Commodore '51 and I-LYA Commodore '75) presented a copy of an article taken from the magazine, "Mid-American Boating," dated 5/20/81 to the Board during our Semi-Annual meeting. This article highlights the BLYC's Diamond (75th). Anniversary.

As we start to reflect upon our history in anticipation of our 100th, portions of the article will be reprinted in

#### BLYC's Diamond Anniversary

Mid-American Boating, AI Mastics, 5/20/81, part 1:

A diamond anniversary comes only once in a lifetime. When a yachting club reaches that age, it is a real cause for celebration! Buckeye Lake Yacht Club is saluting it 75th birthday this year, (1981).

The BLYC is located approximately 24 miles east of Columbus on an island lake that was an important link in the Ohio-Erie Canal system.

It was 1906, when George H. Watkins, a canal superintendent and president of the State Board of Public Works, discussed with a number of his boating oriented friends the recreational advantages of organized boating - sailing, fishing, and perhaps motor boating.

Under his leadership, 15 men met to organize the BLYC on April 4, 1906. That Memorial Day, electric interurban cars brought guests from Circleville, Columbus and Newark. The club grew rapidly, with 84 members listed on its roster for 1906. Annual dues were \$4 after a \$2 initiation fee. (to be continued)
