



Revised PHRF Ratings Posted

I first had a meeting with Ed Riley and Stone Parker to review all of last season's records and results. We also went over the previous season's PHRF's; and we arrived at some preliminary ratings.

I then had a meeting with Steve Harris and Stone Parker to review these ratings and make any changes that may have been needed. After these two meetings, I eliminated all decimal point ratings and went with whole numbers, only. With that in mind, what follows are the "official" BLYC PHRF ratings for cruisers for the 2006 Lambrecht Cup races. (I've also listed the ratings and multipliers for the 2005 and 2004 seasons as well.) See Chart to the right.


