
House & Grounds



Add in the two bar height tables in the corner (where the two low tables were) with the new stools and the place looks as good (if not better) than many of the "IN" places in Columbus and surrounding areas. They were certainly worth the wait. Many thanks to the Auxiliary. Keep your eyes open for more improvements. They are not done yet.

June 1st the combinations to the dock areas and the storage yard will be changed. This is done every few years to slow down the number of unauthorized people gaining access to our facilities. A letter will be mailed on May 15th informing all concerned of the new combination(s).

I did a walk through of the storage

yard and observed many boats on trailers and trailers with no boats in spaces that are NOT rented and should be open. The new spaces created last year (66 thru 83) have the most violations; but, there are others as well. These spaces ARE NOT FREE to members. If you need a space contact me or the Club to obtain one. Next month I will publish a list of violations.

Article V, Section 4 (a) of the Constitution By-Laws and Rules states "RENTAL shall be required of each Member reserving, retaining, or occupying for his personal use any boat house stall, mooring slip, anchorage, boat storage space, locker, bedroom accommodation, or any other Club Facility subject to rental as determined by the Governors. The amount of rental for each of the several kinds and classes of such facilities shall be as determined by the Governors, as provided in Section 5 of this Article."

This is the time of year that we've all been waiting for. Please enjoy the season and most of all please exercise caution and safety in all of your activities at the lake. We've already had one accident on the lake.....we don't need another.

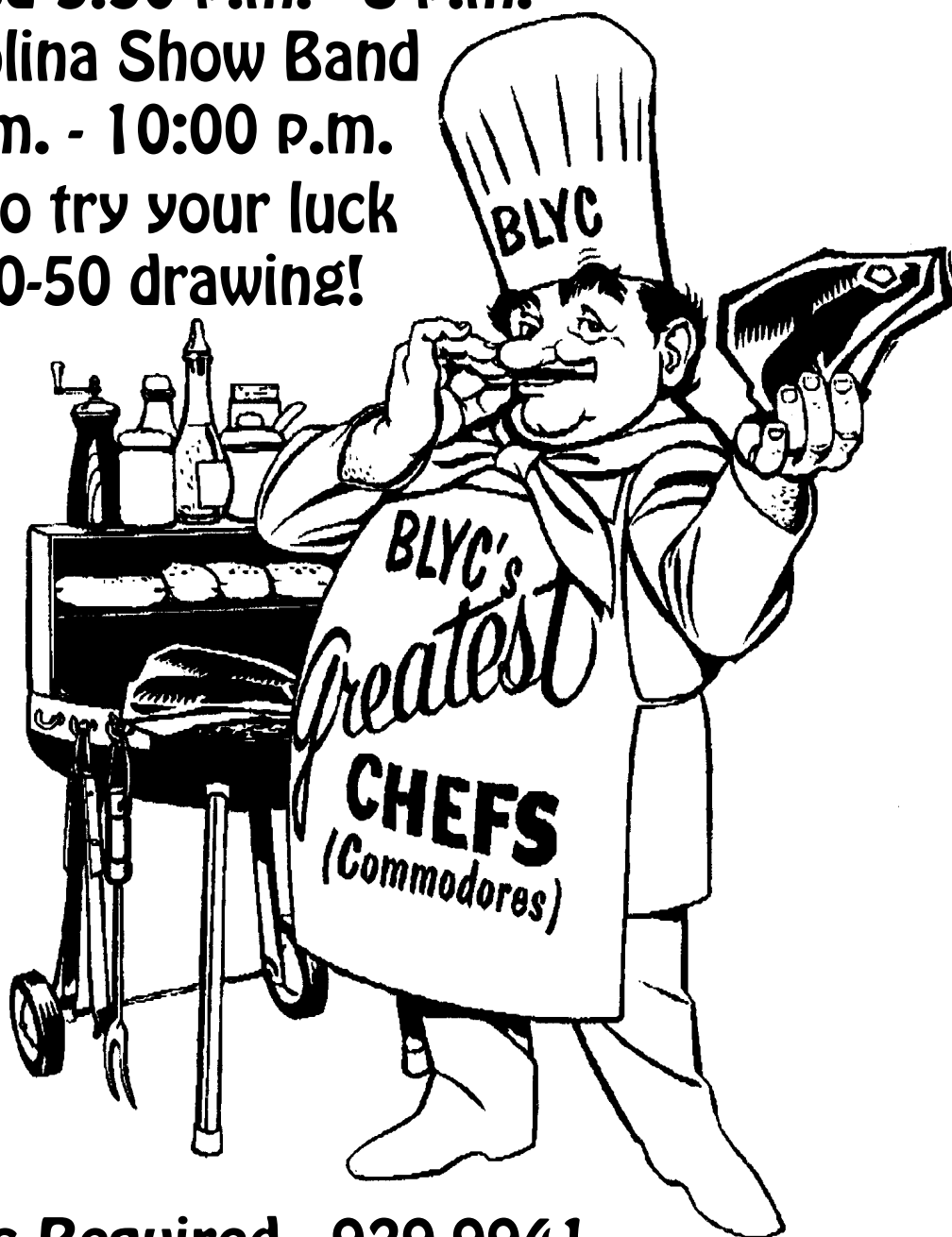
