

Proposed By-Law Amendment

The Board is considering an amendment that enlarges the conditions under which a membership can be transferred to another person. Current Article I, Section 8(a) would be replaced. The new provisions are summarized as follows:

Upon the death of a member or anytime while a member is living, a membership may be transferred to the spouse or the designated domestic partner of the member upon specified conditions and procedures. A "designated domestic partner" is a person who both has continuously cohabited with the member for at least the two years before the death or request for transfer AND was previously designated by the member in writing as the member's regular companion, partner or closely similar status. The person to whom the membership would be transferred must meet the current membership requirements and the procedure is identical to that for becoming a new member except not required are (a) an initiation fee; (b) a recommendation, proposal or seconding; (c) a guest card for obtaining the privileges of the member while the request is pending; and (d) fees, unless the member is in arrears. A request for transfer is made by submitting a membership application.

If the request for transfer is approved by the Board, the transferee member shall continue to pay the financial obligations and shall succeed to all outstanding obligations and privileges of the transferor member except an office in BLYC. The Board shall maintain a record of persons designated as a designated domestic partner.

There is a grandfather provision for requests submitted within one year of adoption of the By-Law revision by the Board. In the Board's discretion, a person requesting transfer may be treated as a designated domestic partner if the Board is satisfied that they meet the above criteria but they were not designated because this By-Law did not exist or the member was unaware of it.

BLYC is pleased to be hosting a US SAILING Race Management Seminar this spring on Saturday, April 23. This seminar is co-sponsored by US SAILING's Race Management Committee and the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club. The seminar is intended for those interested in learning more about working on Race Committee and their very crucial role in our sport. It is geared towards those with some experience and those new to race management alike. Not only is it a great introduction or refresher to race committee work, but you'll likely

find benefit to your own racing knowledge as well. For those interested in US SAIL-ING certification, this seminar fulfills the training requirement for that certification. Participants are encouraged, but not required, to take the certification test at the conclusion of the seminar.
