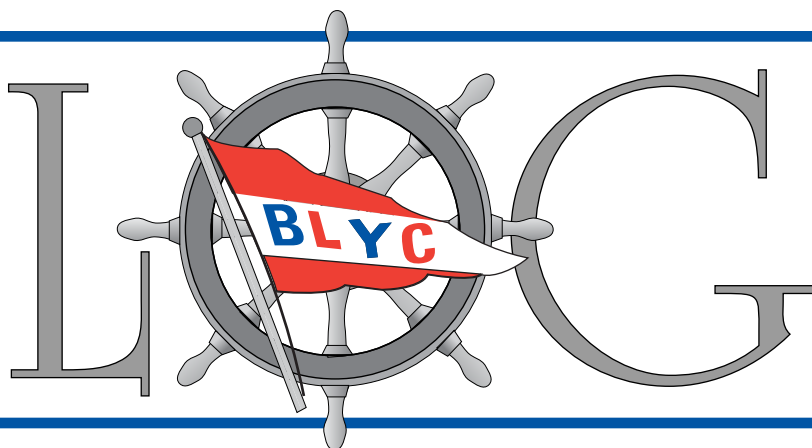

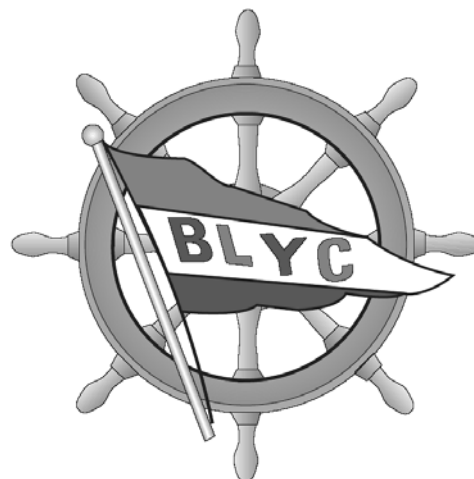
Friends Show." Now that the Sahara, Sands and other Las Vegas landmarks have closed this is the last place to hear the music of the days of the Rat Pack.

submit this form if you wish to cancel or change your assigned space or add a boat hoist. All changes require prior approval.

Each dock holder and boatyard renter is requested to help in the responsibility to make sure the gates are locked when entering and exiting these areas. This will help to ensure that both you and your neighbors' property is protected.

An early reminder that the Classic Boat Regatta is August 19-21 and we are asking that Watkins Island dock holders make their slips available during this event.

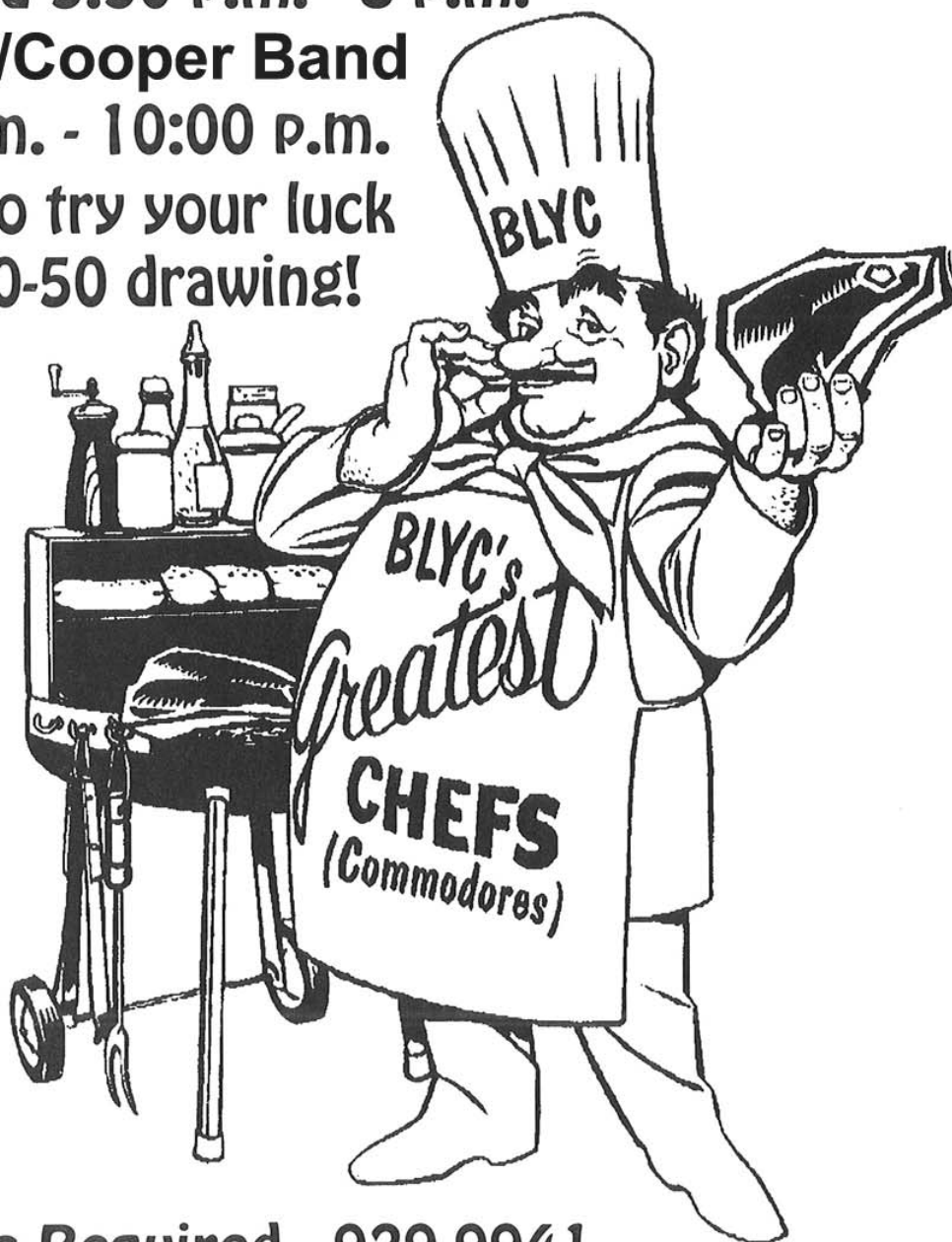
