

very popular, despite the news media reports of the lake water being unsafe. The lake is open and the water quality is safe for recreational use.

We currently have several docks available to rent, at different locations. We have one garage and several spaces available in the storage yard. There is a long waiting list for the covered and area 3 docks. The updated list is below.

If you are interested in renting a dock, garage, storage space, or making any changes, please complete the "Rental Request Form". It is available on the BLYC web site, under facilities and docks or at the office.

New rentals will be half the yearly rate as of August 1, through the end of year.

If you see green flagging on a dock post, it means that the slip is available for temporary tie up while you visit the club.

I must remind each dock holder and boat yard renter to secure the gates as you enter or exit. This will help to protect both you and your neighbors' property from theft and vandalism.

The Classic Boat Regatta is August 19-21. We are asking that Watkins Island dock holders make their slips available during this event.
